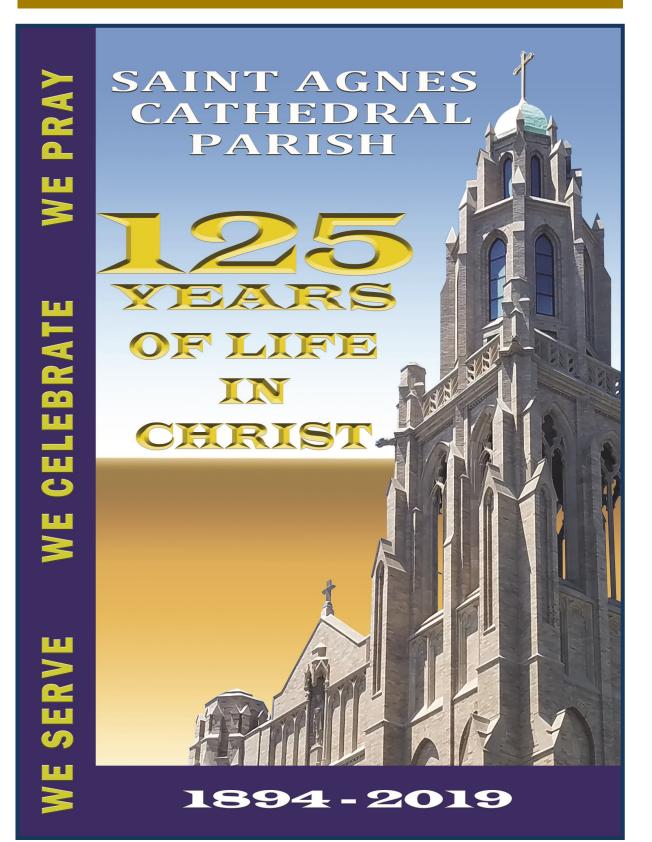
Annual Summary of Spiritual Life and Financial Stewardship August 31, 2018



Dear Parishioners:

Please find on the following pages the Spiritual and Financial Reports for the Pastoral year of September 2017 to August 2018.

As we look at the spiritual life of our parish, it is evident that we have remained relatively consistent over these years in regard to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist as well as the numbers of those who are in spiritual formation. Once again, we are blessed by all the efforts of Sister Kathleen Murphy and her dedicated volunteers who work so well through the Office of Social Ministry in meeting the needs of parishioners and those in our neighborhoods.

I thank the members of our parish's Finance Committee for their work in overseeing the temporalities of our parish. I am pleased to say that with the installation of the exterior lighting on the south façade of the Cathedral, the restoration of the Cathedral is complete. I especially thank everyone who supported this work. Between the pointing of the bricks and stonework on the exterior as well as the refurbishment of the pews, interior lighting, painting and work in the sanctuary, we spent over \$7.8 million dollars. Our ability to do this was largely due to the faith-filled response of so many.

As we turn to this year's financial report, you will notice that there was a \$91,000 operating loss. We were able to cover this loss by going into our savings. However, the Finance Committee and I are very aware that this practice will not be sustainable for the future. Over these years, we have been diligent in monitoring our expenditures and we will certainly continue to do so. As you know from your own household expenses, however, the cost of living is an inescapable factor in rising expenses and this is certainly the situation in our parish when it comes to utilities, insurance, employee medical benefits and so on. The Finance Committee has also discussed areas to which we might look to increase our revenue and we will continue to do so. In the meantime, however, I express my deepest thanks to everyone whose support—both spiritually and materially—enables our parish to proclaim Christ in word and deed.
