Devotions

Jesus is waiting for you!

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sunshaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon

Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:30—5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer. We will offer this in place of our normal Friday Adoration in the Holy Cross Chapel, which is suspended for the time being.

Nocturnal Adoration has resumed in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00—10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Saturday in the Cathedral except on the First Saturday, when it is recited at 8:30 a.m.

Please remember to sit in every other pew and maintain social distancing. All visitors must wear a mask inside the Cathedral and Chapel.

Mass Reminders During COVID-19

Thank you for helping us keep the Cathedral and Parish Center safe for worship during these challenging times. Let us continue to be as vigilant as possible for the safety of others as we gather together to give Glory and Praise to God.

Please be reminded that all COVID-19 protocols remain in effect, particularly having face coverings at all times while in the Cathedral and the Parish Center. It is also important that we keep a distance of 6 feet from others while inside, especially during the reception of Holy Communion.





Because of concerns regarding the coronavirus, we request that those who choose to receive on the tongue please present themselves to the priest only to receive Holy Communion. We also kindly remind

everyone to please remove your mask before receiving Holy Communion, whether you choose to receive on the tongue or in the hand. The Diocese of Rockville Centre leaves the choice to receive in the hand or on the tongue at the discretion of each communicant.



Principal's Announcements

Who hasn't felt discouraged at some point in life? We all know how it feels when things don't go the way we want or expect. John the Baptist

was feeling that way in today's Gospel. He is suffering in prison, wondering if all that he said and did had any meaning.

Jesus didn't fit the common image of the Messiah. He wasn't a great political leader who would overthrow the Roman oppressors and restore Israel to glory. John's faith is shaken and so he tells his followers to seek out Jesus and ask him, "Are you the one?"

In response to John's question, Jesus tells him (and us) to look at what he was doing: healing the sick, raising the dead, bringing the good news to the poor. John would have immediately recognized those actions as the ones Isaiah prophesized that the Messiah would do on his arrival. By focusing on those deeds, John would have known that indeed Jesus was the one. Even though the plan wasn't going the way John thought it would, he could be comforted by knowing God was powerfully at work.

Sometimes God doesn't work in our lives the way we expect either. Like John, we can get discouraged and wonder why God is allowing certain struggles and difficulties to happen. That's when we, too, have to realize that the mission of Jesus is not to establish an earthly kingdom, but to restore us to the fullness of life. When we find ourselves feeling dispirited, we need to consider that perhaps God has us exactly where he wants us to be for our perfect good and perfect growth in holiness.


On **Wednesday, December 16th** our Math Olympiad Teams will complete their second math competition test. These students are human calculators! Good luck to them all.
