Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted) in the Cathedral from 2:30–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Please remember to sit in every other pew and maintain social distancing. All visitors must wear a mask inside the Cathedral and Chapel.

2021 Mass Intentions

There is still availability in our 2021 Mass Intention Book for Masses for the late summer and fall months of this year. Please stop by the rectory or call the office at 766-0205 with any questions. Intentions are \$20 per Mass.

Dispensation from Mass

As a reminder, the dispensation from the requirement to attend Sunday Mass remains in effect. Those who are most vulnerable and at a greater risk (due to age, preexisting health conditions or being in close proximity to vulnerable people) are encouraged to remain home at this time. *If a person shows any symptoms of illness, they are asked to please not come to church.* We encourage you to join us for Mass on the Catholic Faith Network (see schedule) or via our Facebook and YouTube livestream (Sundays at 9:30a.m.).



FROM THE RECTOR -

Dear Friends,

This past year has been among the most difficult we have ever experienced. We have all had to adapt our daily lives to the response to the pandemic. We continue to keep in our daily prayers those affected most by COVID, namely those who lost their lives and their dear families. Since the pandemic began, we have taken precautions to keep

St. Agnes as safe as possible for all who visit. This began with stopping Masses altogether and then slowly reintroducing the ability for in-person Mass attendance with some adaptations. We also upgraded the air filters in the Cathedral to the most up to date and advanced MERV-13 technology. We are currently maintaining the usage of masks and hand sanitizers. We have likewise spaced everyone to every other row to maintain the 50% capacity which was imposed upon us by the state government.

I'm happy to tell you that beginning on May 19th, as per the Governor, the seating capacity of St. Agnes Cathedral and every church in New York State will return to 100%. This means that we will remove the ropes from the pews on that date, and we will be able to sit many more people in the Cathedral. We will keep the ropes on the pews in the transepts for those who wish to maintain every other row distance. We encourage you to use common sense and continue to distance yourselves as best as you can. Masks will still be required for all in the Cathedral except children under two years of age and those with medical conditions that prevent them from wearing masks for prolonged periods of time. We encourage all in our community to get the vaccine to continue on our path to normalcy.

Permit me to ask everyone in the church to remove their mask before they say amen in order to allow the priest or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion to see you consume the Holy Eucharist. Unfortunately, we have had too many instances of individuals not properly receiving the Eucharist and walking away with Communion. The Eucharist must be consumed before you leave the presence of the minister.

Allow me to say thank you to all of you for the ways you have cooperated with us in responding to the pandemic. These continue to be difficult times, but I believe we are moving in the right direction!

This past week you should have received an enrollment form for online giving in the mail if you are not currently enrolled. May I humbly ask you to consider signing up for *Faith Direct*, enabling us to plan more effectively for our budgets. It also allows you to be free from having to worry about carrying money or envelopes to church each week.

You may be aware we have had a way of supporting our parish through online giving called Faith Direct. Nearly 500 registered households in The Parish of St. Agnes Cathedral use Faith Direct, even our Rector. I hope you can join us today.

To those of you who are using the Faith Direct service to make your generous donations to our parish, Thank You! Your support has made this way of contributing cost-effective, efficient and a secure way to receive gifts. It also helps us plan accordingly.

The Faith Direct program gives you:

- A convenient and consistent way to support The Parish of St. Agnes Cathedral by electing to use direct debit from your bank or credit card accounts.
- The opportunity to support our parish even if you are absent from Mass for travel or personal reasons.
- A solution to a situation I know some families face on their way to Mass; I can't find my offertory envelopes!

How does it work?

- You can visit faith.direct/NY239 and enroll securely online or text "Enroll" to 516-400-4895
- For those of you who are not comfortable going online, you can still enroll in this program by completing a separate enrollment form and mailing it to Faith Direct. An enrollment form and return envelope has been mailed to parish households. Forms have also been placed in the pews and at the entrances of the Cathedral. They are also available at the Rectory Office. You do not need a computer to give electronically!
- You can elect to have your specified bank or credit card account debited on the 4th of the month for both offertory and any second collections you support.
- Parishioners can elect to receive "offertory cards" in lieu of envelopes to be placed in the collection basket.

A few other considerations:

- As a parish, we can collectively go "green" by eliminating the many envelopes that go unused.
- There is no charge to parishioners for enrolling. In fact, every family signing up with Faith Direct eliminates a package of envelopes to be printed and mailed out and that will mean savings for our parish, which we can use to help meet our budgetary obligations.
- We consider Faith Direct to be a "win-win" program for both parishioners and our parish. We strongly encourage you to enroll in this opportunity today. Our parish has complete confidence in its security. Thank you for your consideration and we are grateful for your financial and prayerful support of The Parish of St. Agnes Cathedral.






