

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted) in the Cathedral from 2:30–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Mass Reminders

Thank you for keeping the Cathedral and Parish Center safe for worship in these challenging times.

The seating capacity of all churches in New York State has returned to 100%. We offer the following guidelines while inside the Cathedral and Parish Center for Mass:



The ropes have been removed from the pews of the Cathedral and we will be able to seat more people. For the time being, the ropes will remain on the pews in the transepts

for anyone wishing to sit every other row. Please use common sense and continue to distance yourselves as best you can while seated and during the reception of Holy Communion.

The Diocese of Rockville Centre leaves the choice to receive in the hand or on the tongue at the discretion of each communicant.





As you approach to receive, if you are wearing a mask then please remove your mask before you say amen, so the priest or minister may see you consume the Holy Eucharist. Unfortunately we have had many

instances of individuals not properly receiving and walking away with Communion.

The Eucharist must be consumed before you leave the presence of the minister.

To receive in the hand:

 place your hand out <u>straight and flat</u> to avoid contact with the priest or minister's hand

To receive on the tongue:

 please go to the priest only and open your mouth and extend your tongue to avoid contact with his hand

Dispensation from Mass

Currently, the dispensation from the requirement to attend Sunday Mass in person remains in effect. The Diocese will lift the dispensation on the weekend of August 14/15.

10th Sunday in Ordinary Time A House Divided

Today's Gospel demands our conversion, which is a two-step process. It requires a change of heart and then a turning around toward God. It is both an interior and exterior change, which could be likened to re-aligning yourself to follow your north-facing compass—it first requires a knowledge that you are no longer headed north, and then the willingness to change paths in order to head north. Because conversion requires a change of heart, we know that to be converted, our consciences must be open. Truth must be able to penetrate our thoughts so that we become aware of our failings and shortcomings. When our conscience speaks, we need to conform ourselves to the truth, instead of trying to justify our



wrongdoing. The will then follows the intellect. If we know something to be true and want to embrace that truth, then our actions will begin to follow.

The second step in conversion requires us not just turning away from something but turning toward something else. Conversion is turning away from sin and turning toward God, turning away from vice and toward virtue. The best confessors will not just tell us we need to stop being greedy, but rather will encourage us to break the vice of greed by growing in the virtue of generosity.
