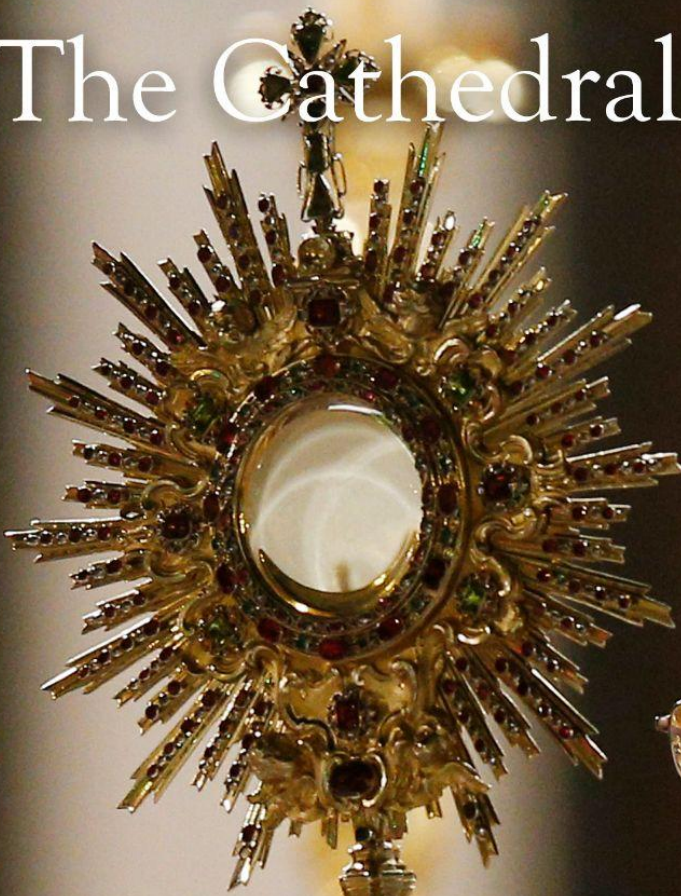

Confession

Saturday, Eve of Holy Day, and Eve of First Friday from 4:00 to 4:45 p.m. Monday Evening following 7:30 p.m. Mass. Wednesday Morning following the 7:45 a.m. Mass and the 12:10 p.m. Mass.

Baptism

Once a month on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. and on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 1:45 p.m. Contact the Rectory Office to arrange for interview, ceremony and registration for required Baptism Preparation Class (for first time parents). Spanish Baptisms take place before the 7:30 p.m. Spanish Mass on Saturday evening. Please call the Rectory Office for more information.

Marriage

Arrangements should be made at least 12 months in advance and prior to making reception plans. Call the Rectory for an appointment with the priest you wish to witness your wedding. All couples are required to attend Pre-Cana.

Pastoral Care of the Sick

Priests and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion are available to bring Holy Communion to parishioners confined to home. Please call the Rectory Office to make arrangements. Those who are seriously ill should request a priest for Anointing of the Sick.

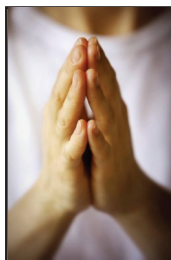

Devotions



Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:30–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Adoration Chapel is Open

The Adoration Chapel (Clinton Avenue entrance) will be open Monday through Saturday from 7:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. On Sundays the chapel will open following the 7:00 a.m. Mass and will close at 6:00 p.m. As a reminder, the Cathedral is open Monday through Friday until 6:30 p.m. On weekends it is open until the completion of that day's final Mass.



Mass Reminders

Thank you for keeping the Cathedral and Parish Center safe for worship in these challenging times.

The seating capacity of all churches in New York State has returned to 100%. We offer the following guidelines while inside the Cathedral and Parish Center for Mass:



The ropes have been removed from the pews of the Cathedral and we will be able to seat more people. For the time being, the ropes will remain on the pews in the transepts

for anyone wishing to sit every other row. Please use common sense and continue to distance yourselves as best you can while seated and during the reception of Holy Communion.

The Diocese of Rockville Centre leaves the choice to receive in the hand or on the tongue at the discretion of each communicant.



As you approach to receive, if you are wearing a mask then please remove your mask before you say amen, so the priest or minister may see you consume the Holy Eucharist.

Unfortunately we have had many instances of individuals not properly receiving and walking away with Communion.

The Eucharist must be consumed before you leave the presence of the minister.

To receive in the hand:

- place your hand out straight and flat to avoid contact with the priest or minister's hand

To receive on the tongue:

- please go to the priest only and open your mouth and extend your tongue to avoid contact with his hand

Dispensation from Mass

Currently, the dispensation from the requirement to attend Sunday Mass remains in effect. The Diocese will lift the dispensation on the weekend of August 14/15.

You may be aware we have had a way of supporting our parish through online giving called Faith Direct. Nearly 500 registered households in The Parish of St. Agnes Cathedral use Faith Direct, even our Rector. I hope you can join us today.

To those of you who are using the Faith Direct service to make your generous donations to our parish, Thank You! Your support has made this way of contributing cost-effective, efficient and a secure way to receive gifts. It also helps us plan accordingly.

The Faith Direct program gives you:

- A convenient and consistent way to support The Parish of St. Agnes Cathedral by electing to use direct debit from your bank or credit card accounts.
- The opportunity to support our parish even if you are absent from Mass for travel or personal reasons.
- A solution to a situation I know some families face on their way to Mass; I can't find my offertory envelopes!

How does it work?

- You can visit **faith.direct/NY239** and enroll securely online or text "**Enroll**" to **516-400-4895**
- For those of you who are not comfortable going online, you can still enroll in this program by completing a separate enrollment form and mailing it to Faith Direct. An enrollment form and return envelope has been mailed to parish households. Forms have also been placed in the pews and at the entrances of the Cathedral. They are also available at the Rectory Office. You do not need a computer to give electronically!
- You can elect to have your specified bank or credit card account debited on the 4th of the month for both offertory and any second collections you support.
- Parishioners can elect to receive "offertory cards" in lieu of envelopes to be placed in the collection basket.

A few other considerations:

- As a parish, we can collectively go "green" by eliminating the many envelopes that go unused.
- There is no charge to parishioners for enrolling. In fact, every family signing up with Faith Direct eliminates a package of envelopes to be printed and mailed out – and that will mean savings for our parish, which we can use to help meet our budgetary obligations.
- We consider Faith Direct to be a "win-win" program for both parishioners and our parish. We strongly encourage you to enroll in this opportunity today. Our parish has complete confidence in its security. Thank you for your consideration and we are grateful for your financial and prayerful support of The Parish of St. Agnes Cathedral.

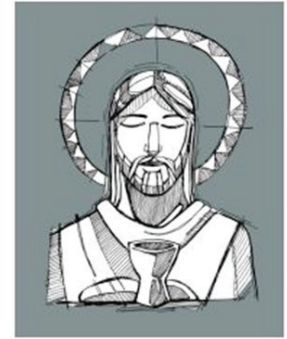

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Corpus Christi



The Catechism tells us that the Eucharist is the “source and summit” of the Christian life. All of the other sacraments point toward the reality of what the Eucharist really is: the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord. What a tremendous and humbling gift to receive the Creator into our hearts and souls!

It can be hard for us to comprehend that Jesus Christ is present, Body, Blood, soul, and divinity in a small piece of bread. This surpasses our human understanding. However, there have been several reported miracles where the Eucharist has transformed into flesh or blood, revealing the truth of this sacrament. In his hands and before his eyes, the precious host turned into flesh and blood. Jesus was indeed present. 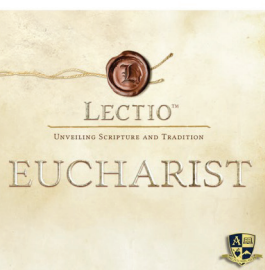
