Pastoral Care of the Sick

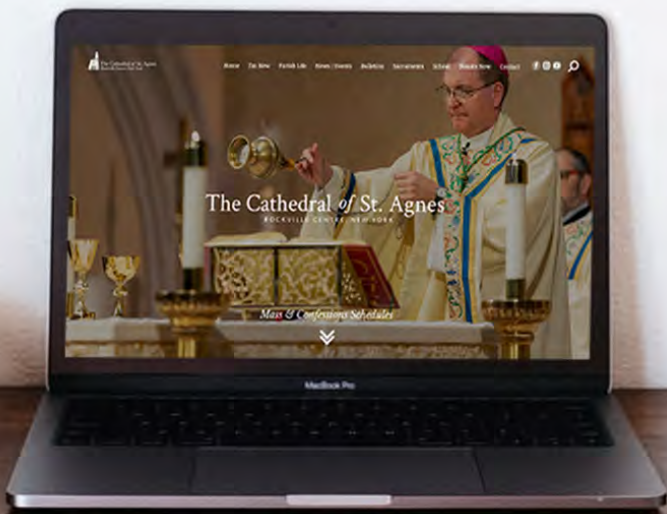

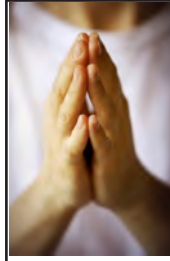
