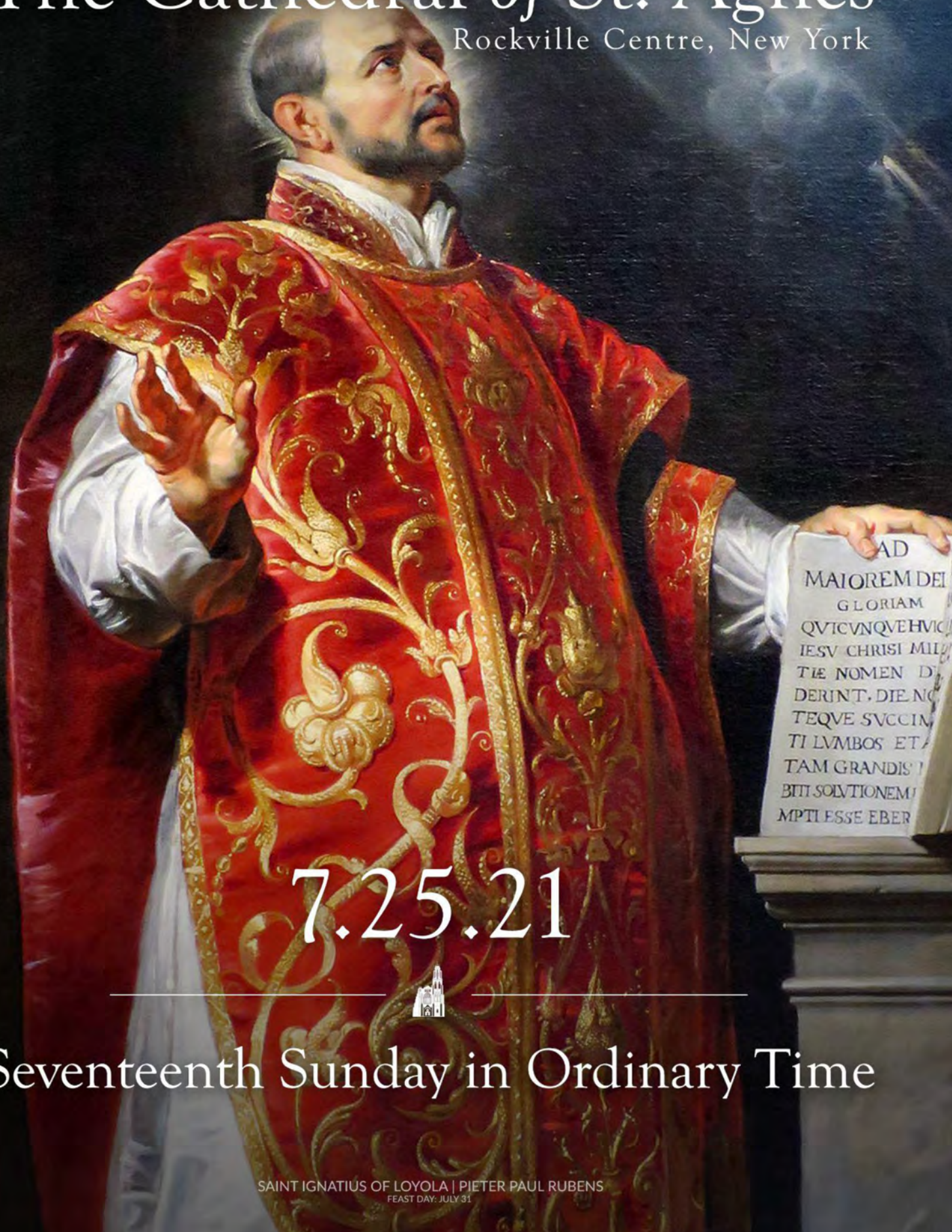

Pastoral Care of the Sick

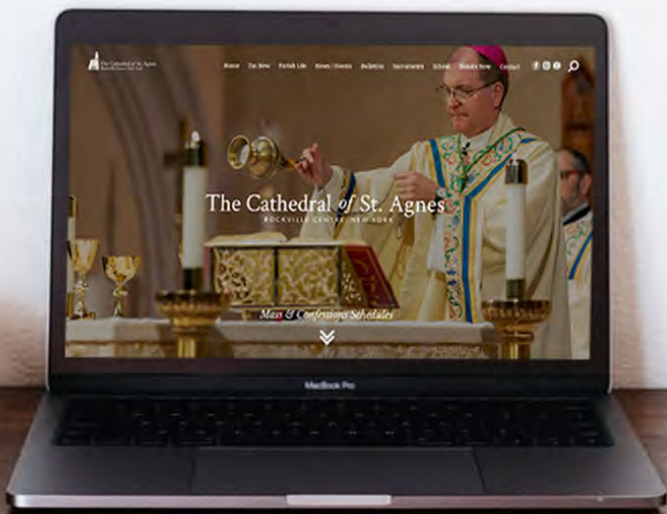

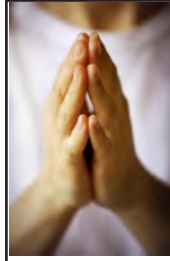

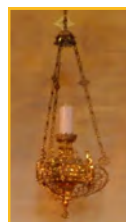

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:30–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

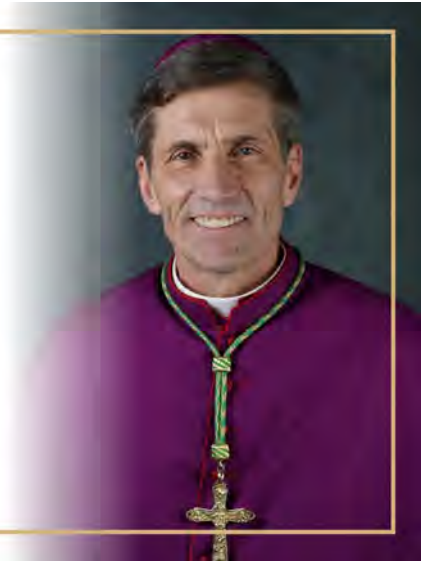

Holy Mass Attendance Obligations



The general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation in the Diocese of Rockville Centre will end on the eve of the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: August 14, 2021. This means that the faithful are required to attend Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation Masses beginning on August 14, 2021. This obligation does not apply to those who are ill, those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility, or those with serious underlying health conditions. Consult your local pastor if you have questions about the obligation to attend Mass.

Although the “obligation” to keep the Lord’s Day holy and participate in the Holy Mass is a most serious commandment, it is better understood as a profound act of love. The greatest love the world will ever know is the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross for our salvation. Every Mass is a chance for us to be a part of that Divine love here on earth and to prepare for eternal life with God in Heaven. We should hunger for our Lord’s presence in the Eucharist / Holy Communion and desire to be a part of the Mass every Sunday. Keep watch for announcements from your parish on special prayer opportunities leading to Mary’s Feast Day on August 15.

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly



Earlier this year, Pope Francis established the fourth Sunday of July as the annual World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Bishop John Barres has commissioned the Diocese of Rockville Centre's Office of Human Life, Family and Bioethics with leading the diocesan celebration honoring the important role of grandparents in passing on the faith and recognizing the value of all those in our community who are "rich in many years."

This year, World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated on Sunday, July 25, with the theme "I am with you always" to focus on the closeness of God with the aged, and the closeness of intergenerational ties. The temporal proximity to the Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne (July 26, 2021), the grandparents of Jesus, is intended to reinforce the vital role of family in honoring the gifts of age. "In preparing for this day, we can contemplate the profound beauty of our Catholic faith and traditions, the giving and receiving of love through our generational ties, and the perpetual communion we share with our forebearers," said Lisa A. Honkanen, M.D., director of the Office of Human Life, Family and Bioethics.

As part of the promotion of this initiative a new website was created that serves as a source of information and inspiration on World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly: CatholicGenerations.com. The website contains information aimed at letting seniors who may be lonely know they are remembered and to help grandparents convey their Catholic faith and traditions to their grandchildren.

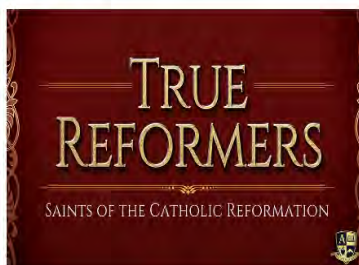
