**Nocturnal Adoration** is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

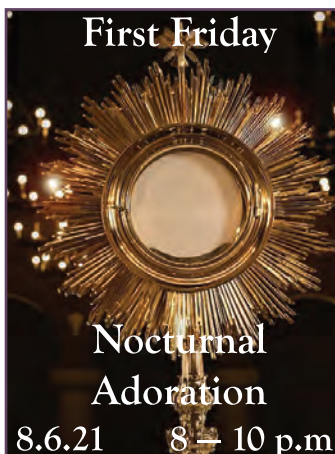

## Holy Mass Attendance Obligations



The general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation in the Diocese of Rockville Centre will end on the eve of the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: August 14, 2021. This means that the faithful are required to attend Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation Masses beginning on August 14, 2021. This obligation does not apply to those who are ill, those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility, or those with serious underlying health conditions. Consult your local pastor if you have questions about the obligation to attend Mass.

Although the “obligation” to keep the Lord’s Day holy and participate in the Holy Mass is a most serious commandment, it is better understood as a profound act of love. The greatest love the world will ever know is the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross for our salvation. Every Mass is a chance for us to be a part of that Divine love here on earth and to prepare for eternal life with God in Heaven. We should hunger for our Lord’s presence in the Eucharist / Holy Communion and desire to be a part of the Mass every Sunday. Keep watch for announcements from your parish on special prayer opportunities leading to Mary’s Feast Day on August 15.

## Remembering Sister Jane Doherty, OP



Sister Jane Doherty (Sister Kathleen Michele), a Dominican sister for almost 64 years who served our parish school, was welcomed into the fullness of life of God on July 19, 2021. She received her religious name, Sister Kathleen Michele in 1958, was professed in August, 1959 and then assigned to teach at St. Agnes Elementary School until 1962. After a few other assignments, she returned in 1970 to serve as our school's principal for nine years. She later moved on to serve as the Executive Secretary of the National Catholic Vocation Council and various parishes on Long Island and in Queens. Jane's funeral mass was held on July 23rd at St. Albert Chapel in Amityville and she was laid to rest in the Sisters' cemetery. She will be missed by her family and all her Dominican Sisters.

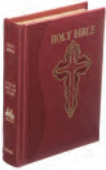
