Pastoral Care of the Sick





You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:30–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Principal's Announcements

“Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me.”

In this week's Gospel, Jesus is nearing the end of his journeys with his disciples. Soon after these events, he will turn towards Jerusalem to face his Passion. He is beginning to pull his Apostles aside for intimate moments, revealing more deeply his heart, teachings, and mission on earth.



The Apostles have spent almost three years with Jesus, but here it is evident that they still don't fully know him. It can be challenging to watch them misunderstand Jesus so many times, but we can relate to them more than we realize. Because Jesus is God, there will always be things about him that we cannot fully understand because our minds are finite. Moreover, the ways of God are not like our ways. His kingdom, his mission, and his promises aren't what we expect. The logic of the Gospel is the logic of God, not of humans. Today, Jesus wants to pull us aside for an intimate moment to reveal his heart more deeply to us and to teach us his logic that will lead to our true joy, just as he did for his Apostles.

Blood Drive

On Sunday, September 26, 2021 the next Parish Blood Drive will be held here in the Msgr. Kelly Parish Center. The St. Agnes Knights of Columbus will be holding this event in memory of their fellow Knight Tom Toy. He would have been 84 this September, the day after the blood drive, but sadly passed away in October 2020 from cancer. Tom would have been so proud but even more humbled.

Tom's commitment to donating blood began when he was in college and continued throughout his life.

In 1990, that commitment became more intense when our daughter, Betsy, began a long battle with leukemia. During that time, she had many blood transfusions that continuously showed us the meaning of the words "Gift of Life". Every time she would receive a transfusion it gave her the strength to fight her illness.

After our daughter passed, we volunteered to run the blood drive and through the years we have had the honor of receiving awards on behalf of the Parish from the Long Island Blood Services for ***MOST DONATIONS*** collected at a drive. Sometimes the lines were long and others not. When the turnout has been low, we've wondered what could we do? We couldn't help but remember the blood drive that was held in the aftermath of

September 11, 2001. The community responded in overwhelming numbers, the lines were out the door and down the block. There wasn't any way we could have been prepared for that incredible response, in fact we had to turn people away because we did not have enough staff or supplies. Sadly, a crisis like that can happen again, but for many crises exist on a day-to-day basis. Accidents and illness often result in the need for blood, and there are often shortages in the hospitals.

On behalf of myself, our family, and the Knights of Columbus (who continue on to run the blood drive in honor of Tom) I would like to encourage prayers for the success of the drive; for those in need of this special "Gift of Life", and for those who can and do make the decision to serve others in this special way.




