



Principal's Announcements

In this week's Gospel reading, the disciples come to Jesus about

someone who is casting out demons in his name, even though this individual is not a visible member of the group of disciples. Jesus uses this moment to teach the disciples that he is the source of our unity in Faith. When St. Paul says that we are members of the Body of Christ, he means that our unity is a consequence of Christ's action in us and for us. Jesus likewise says, "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you" (John 15:16).

In the end, God is entirely free to distribute His grace as He wishes. The person expelling the demons in Jesus's name may not have been a visible member of the disciples, but his faith in Christ and his actions testifying to his faith are effective because of the power of the name of Jesus (Philippians 2:9-11). This same theme is present in the first reading from Numbers, in which God's power is shown to be effective in accordance with his will, apart from human expectations. God's Divine Providence should be a source of joy for us. Today's Gospel should remind us that God's grace is always a gift, and it is never something that is earned.






