## Principal's Announcements

### The Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time



*You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.*

Normally, Jesus's conversations with the prevailing religious authorities are adversarial, but in today's Gospel, a scribe approaches Jesus in all sincerity to discover whether he has an accurate grasp on the Law of God. Jesus responds to his question about the Greatest Commandment by referring to the Shema of Deuteronomy 6, which was our First Reading. Love of God is the center of the Law, yet Jesus goes one step further, to say that the Greatest Commandment is twofold, to include love of neighbor, a law that he quotes from Leviticus 19:18. All of the commandments can be summarized under these two headings: love of God and love of neighbor. Jesus adds that to love God

in neighbor "is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices" (v. 33). Jesus approves of his reply, but then subtly challenges him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God" (v. 34). Thus, in this Gospel passage, we are given the Greatest Commandment, which should be the source of our actions and meditations.

# SACRED RELICS OF THE SAINTS

## *Treasures of the Church*



Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross is on Long Island with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the “Little Flower”), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic.
