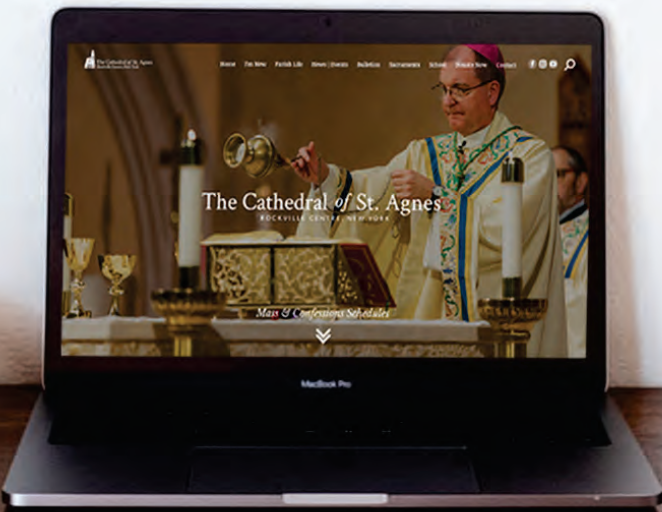

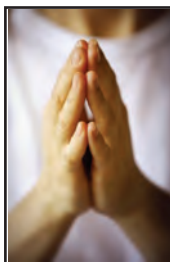

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Advent Solemn Vespers

Next Sunday, November 28th the Church begins a new liturgical year and we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent. Please join us in the Cathedral each Sunday evening at 7:30 p.m. for Solemn Vespers, November 28th, December 5th, 12th and 19th. All are welcome.



From the Rector —

Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe that we have arrived once again at Thanksgiving. Our society it seems is happy enough to celebrate this day for just a brief moment before moving on to Christmas and the spending spree that accompanies it. But for us as Catholics this secular holiday of Thanksgiving is actually integral to our faith.

Thanksgiving, in its very word, portrays the fact that it is, by its nature, a religious day. As a people, we give thanks TO someone. We thank God himself for all of the gifts that we have received, for life, for our faith, for our families. Gratitude is that action and attitude that changes our perspective, our attitude, our very lives. It is not something that comes naturally to us but must be cultivated and practiced. Gratitude is a virtue that brings us out of ourselves and our myopic world view and allows us to see the world and creation as God does.

As Catholics, we practice this virtue and cultivate an attitude of thanksgiving every time we come to Holy Mass. The word Eucharist comes from the Greek word for thanksgiving. Each time we approach the altar, we offer the sacrifice of Christ to the Father in thanksgiving for all that we are and all that we have. As a priest, Thanksgiving morning Mass is among my favorite Masses of the year, namely because no one has to be there, it is not a day of obligation, but is instead a treasured opportunity to thank God. I invite each of you to consider attending Mass on Thanksgiving morning at 9 am as a family. The bird will still be cooking. The company won't have arrived yet. The cleaning can be done right after Mass. Come to St Agnes and actually give TO someone! Allow yourself the time to give thanks to God properly, at Holy Mass.

As we come out of this pandemic more and more each day (please God!) we should stop and give thanks for so many blessings. During this month of the Holy Souls, we also particularly remember those who are no longer with us and who we will miss tremendously at our Thanksgiving table.

Please know that when I gather with my family this Thanksgiving evening I will be giving thanks in particular for each of you and for the way you have entered into my heart.

I will be praying for all of you during our Mass on Thanksgiving morning.

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe



This Sunday brings the liturgical year of the Church to its culmination. At the close of the year, the Church draws our attention to Jesus's Kingship and the coming of his Kingdom through this Sunday's readings. John's Gospel digs deep into this theme of God's kingdom, so this year we are uniquely primed to enter into the mystery we celebrate today.

Because God's ways are not our ways, so God's Kingdom is not like the kingdoms of the earth. While those of his time may have expected a king of strength who crushes his political enemies, Jesus instead comes as an infant child, and then suffers and dies on the Cross, which was the most heinous form of punishment in those days. We expect a kingdom that will never suffer under unjust rule again, but Jesus suffers so that we may enter into his very suffering and through his death, experience the Resurrection of the Dead and everlasting joy.

While we will not experience true rest until Heaven, God's Kingdom exists already here on this earth, through the grace of Christ in his sacraments, which have been given to the Church. Through these sacraments, especially the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, we can begin to experience heaven on earth.

On Monday, November 22nd, the school children will participate in our annual Laps for Hunger event during their recess period. Students should wear their gym uniforms to school on Monday and bring in a \$2.00

donation. Money collected will be split between St. Agnes Cathedral's Parish Pantry and The Mary Brennan Inn.

Charles spent 17 years deployed at military bases throughout the world. Returning home after an incident involving nerve gas, he began struggling with debilitating bouts of anxiety and depression.

His circumstances worsened and he couldn’t maintain a steady job. Charles moved in with his mother, but within a year she died and his childhood home went into foreclosure.

Catholic Charities’ *Project Veterans’ Independence*, which guides homeless veterans into permanent housing so they can live independently and have access to support networks that get them back on their feet, reached out and helped Charles.

Charles pasó 17 años de su vida asignado a diferentes bases militares en diversas partes del mundo. Después de sufrir un ataque con armas químicas, regresó a casa; y al poco tiempo comenzó a sentir depresión y terribles ataques de ansiedad.

Su situación fue cada vez peor y le impidió mantener un empleo estable. Charles se mudó de regreso a vivir con su madre. Pero en cuestión de un año, ella falleció y la casa -donde él había vivido desde su niñez- fue embargada.

El ‘*Proyecto Veteranos Independientes*’ de Caridades Católicas contactó a Charles. Este programa ayuda y guía a veteranos sin hogar a conseguir una vivienda permanente y vivir independientemente. El programa facilita el acceso a redes de asistencia y los ayudan a salir adelante.


