You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Principal's Announcements

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



In today's second reading, Saint Paul paints a word picture in this passage to help quell some of the dissension that was apparently rife in the church in Corinth. He draws out in a colorful way the implications of the doctrine of the church as the Body of Christ. The unity of the members of the Church is to be like that of the various parts of one body. That is, the limbs of a body don't compete for primacy or pull in different directions; they cooperate because they're unified by the single intention or purpose that's supplied by the head. Church unity is to be an actual, organic unity like that of the body. Whenever we speak of our Church we speak of ourselves. Saint Paul calls us to celebrate the differences between the different members of the Body of Christ. Just as a body needs an ear, an arm, and every other part to be whole, the Church, as the Body of Christ, needs every one of its diverse members to be whole. We must ensure the well-being of each of its parts.

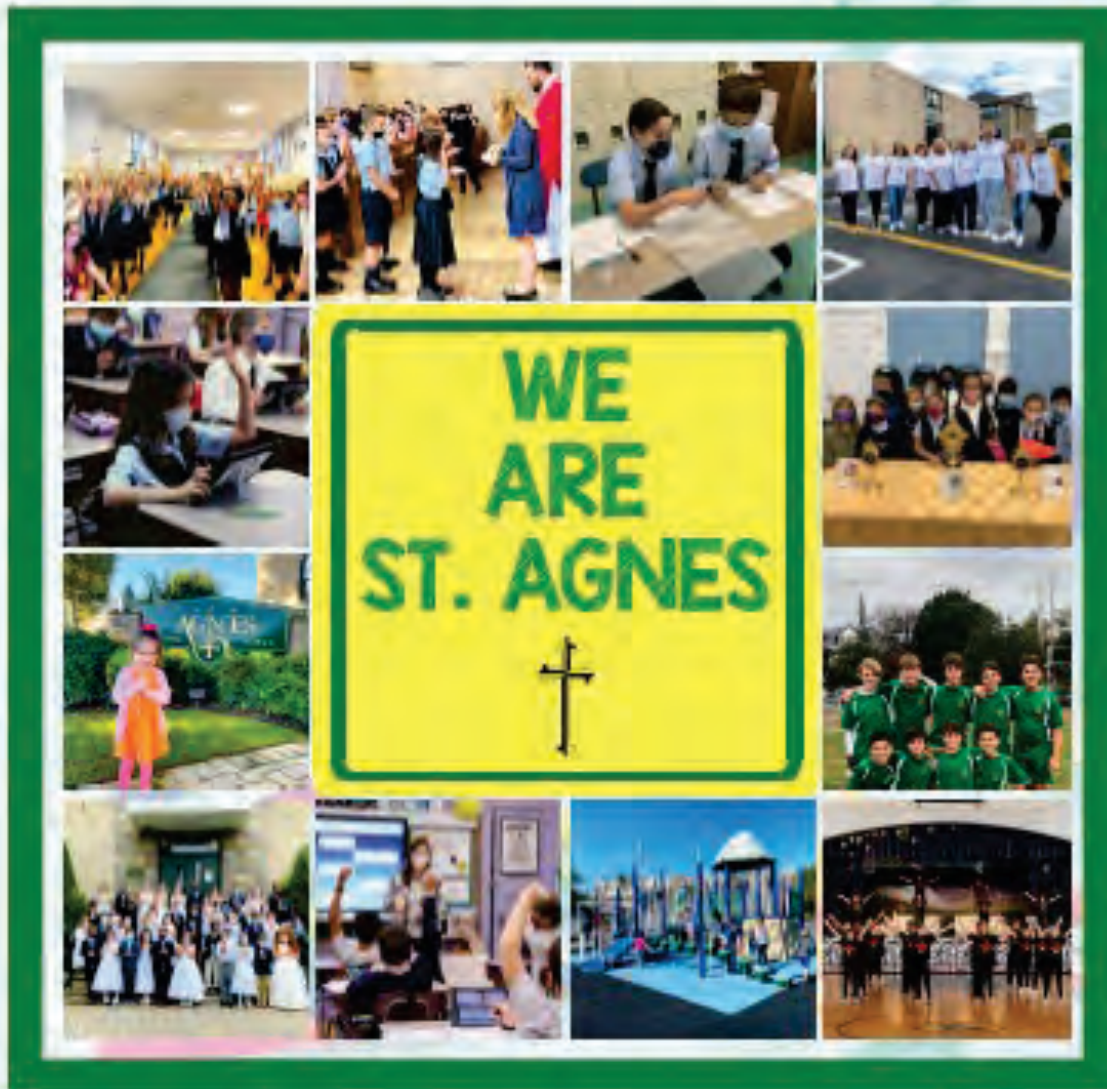
