You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

**Nocturnal Adoration** is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

**The Rosary** is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

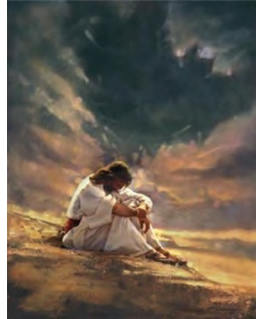




## Principal's Announcements

First Sunday of Lent

### Resisting Temptation



We begin the season of Lent by joining Jesus in the desert where he is tempted by the devil. Satan tempts Jesus in three ways, which represent the same three tactics he commonly employs today to get us to break our relationship with God.

First, Satan tries to undermine Jesus' identity as the Son of God. He does the same thing with us—he tries to undermine our dignity and identity as sons and daughters of God.

Second, Satan offers Jesus the kingdoms of the world. Satan tempts us too to seek power and influence in this world in order to further enslave us in an endless quest for control.

Finally, Satan tempts Jesus to fulfill his mission in a way other than the one ordained by the Father. In the same way, we are often tempted to find an easier or more "successful" way to live our lives, instead of trusting the Father's plan.

Jesus answers Satan in all three of these temptations with the Word of God because God's Word has power to resist and overcome evil. That is one reason why it is so important to become steeped and grounded in Scripture: in order to have a ready sword of truth which we can use to defend ourselves against the lies and snares of evil. Let us join Jesus in the desert in this week's Gospel reading and learn how we can better resist the temptations of the devil in our own lives today.

Congratulations to our 8th graders who received the sacrament of Confirmation on Friday, March 5th.

**May the Spirit of the Lord dwell in their hearts all the days of their lives!**

Lent offers us all a very special opportunity to grow in our relationship with God and to deepen our commitment to a way of life, rooted in our baptism. In our busy world, Lent provides us with an opportunity to reflect upon our patterns, to pray more deeply, experience sorrow for what we've done and failed to do, and to be generous to those in need. As we fast, give alms and pray, we are led to show love for others who lack the basic essentials for life. It is through these actions that we are led to transformation. This year's school-wide Lenten project is underway. It is based on the school's theme **We Follow the Son**. Each grade will perform acts of kindness throughout the 40 days of Lent. They will write their acts of kindness on the "Sonflowers" that will be on display by the cross in the school's main hallway. **The "Sonflowers" are growing with their acts of kindness!**

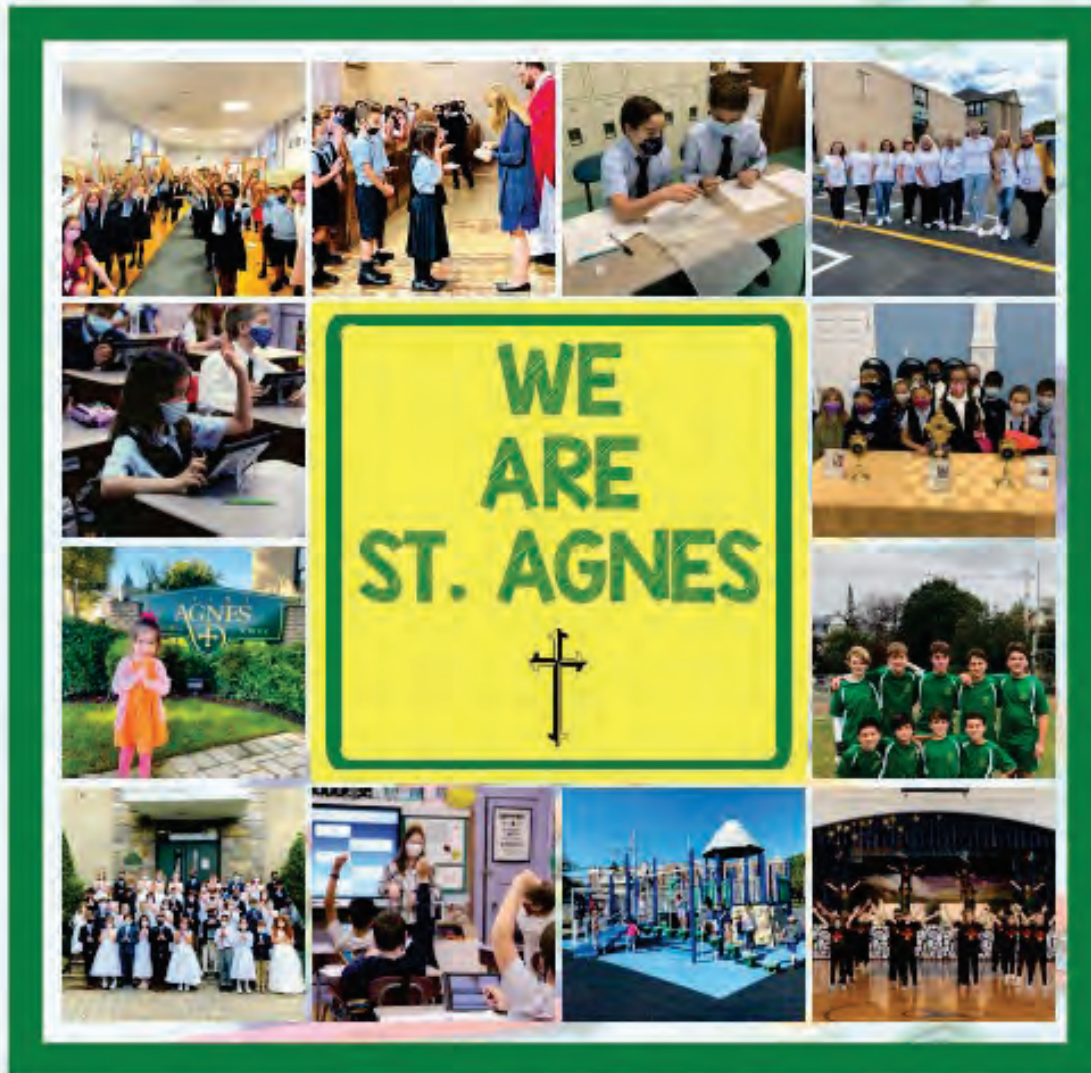

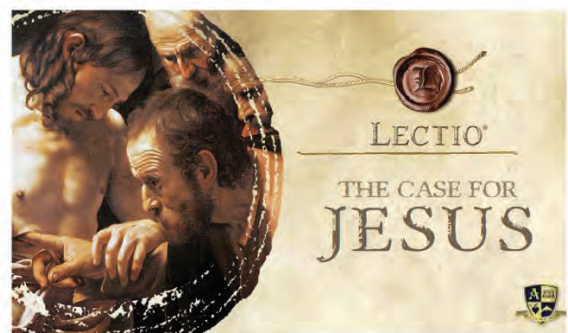

**LECTIO: THE CASE FOR JESUS**

In nine sessions, Dr. Brant Pitre answers the key question of faith: Who is Jesus? Dr. Pitre presents evidence from early Christian and non-Christian writings that attest to the authenticity of the Gospels. Timed to lead up to the Triduum, Dr. Pitre looks in-depth at the accounts of Jesus's Crucifixion and Resurrection and his proclamation of divinity.

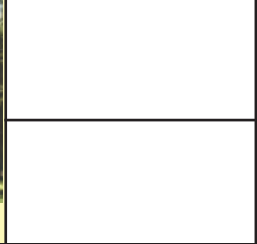
