Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Principal's Announcements



In this week's Gospel, we learn of the promise that Jesus made to send His Holy Spirit to "teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." It is this Spirit, which we await in our anticipation of the Solemnity of Pentecost, who is the "living memory" and the "principle of every vital and truly saving action" in the Body of Christ, the Church (CCC 798 and 1099; Pius XII, encyclical, *Mystici Corporis*: DC 3808; Cf. John 14:26).

The same Spirit which Jesus promised and then sent when he had returned to the right hand of the Father in heaven inspired the apostles to say in their letter to the Gentile believers that we saw in the first reading. With the Father and Son, the Holy Spirit comes to dwell in us by Baptism, making each of us a "temple of the holy Spirit." This surprising promise, that the creator will come to dwell in his creation, is one we ought to constantly return to and rely upon. Great masters of the spiritual life from St. Augustine of Hippo to St. Teresa of Avila remind us that heaven is within us by Baptismal grace. The soul in grace need not go to mountaintops or to the great cathedrals to find God, for he is "more interior to me than my inmost self," and well as "higher than my highest self." (St. Augustine)


