Pastoral Care of the Sick

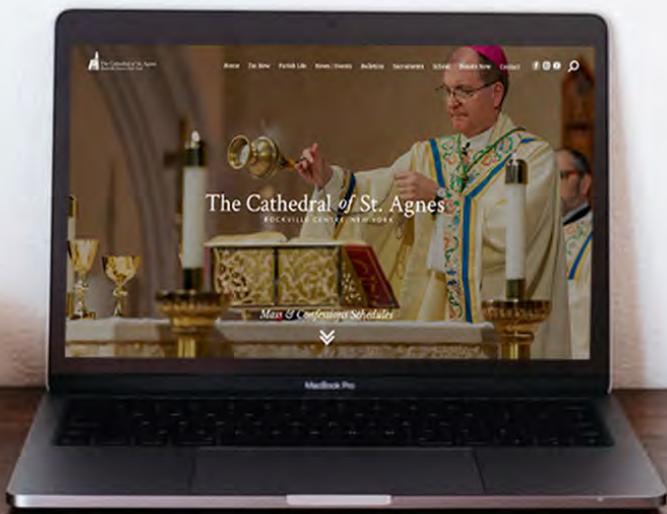

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

Nocturnal Adoration is held in the Holy Cross Chapel on the First Friday night of each month from 8:00–10:00 p.m.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Annual School Supply Collection

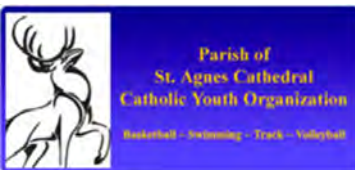

In the News: Religious Exemptions to Covid-19 Vax Still Being Denied

New York - New York Police Department Officer Marjel Kola, is suing the department after they denied him a religious exemption and fired him on June 17, 2022. Kola is a native of Albania, a member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church and has been a transit cop for over 4 years. He received the "Cop of the Month" award in June 2021. When the Covid vaccine became mandatory, Kola applied for a religious exemption and was immediately denied. "I believe in God and put the trust in God. Why should I put something in my body that I don't trust?" he said. ⁽¹⁾ He appealed and submitted a letter from his pastor stating that Kola has been an elder of the church since 2017 and follows its teachings. Still, he was terminated in June.

Air Force - Air Force officials were ordered on July 27, 2022, not to discipline airmen who are seeking religious exemptions to the military's Covid vaccine mandate. U.S. District Judge Matthew McFarland asked the military to make its case as to why he shouldn't enter a preliminary injunction, which is a longer-lasting measure. "Defendants fail to raise any persuasive arguments," Judge McFarland said. The small number of religious exemptions granted is "farcical". The Air Force "has effectively stacked the deck against service members seeking religious exemptions." ⁽²⁾

Chicago - The "first class wide lawsuit for health care workers over a Covid shot mandate" in the United States was settled for over \$10.3 million on July 29, 2022, Liberty Council reported. ⁽³⁾ The lawsuit was against NorthShore University Health System, located in the suburbs of Chicago, on behalf of current and former workers who objected to its Covid shot mandate on religious grounds. They refused the shot due to its association with aborted fetal cells, according to Liberty Counsel. 523 workers had requested and were denied a religious exemption or accommodation. NorthShore had approved the request from one person.

The 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel reading we see people vying for places of honor. Jesus, however, challenges us to do just the opposite: to seek the "lowest place." While many in the world compete for worldly prestige and honor, Jesus is asking Christians to outdo one another in the practice of true humility. Real honor comes from seeking the glory of God, not the praise of men. We know from our experience that the honors of this world are fleeting. The trophy, the new position, the praise from your boss, and the time visiting with a famous person will not fulfill us. They ultimately are just smoke that will blow away and leave us only hungering for more. And when we seek recognition from others or go out of our way to draw attention to ourselves, our quest for worldly glory distracts us from finding our true identity and fulfillment in life which come from God alone. If we seek the "lowest place" with sincerity, however, we will have more room for God in our hearts. God will see our humility and bless us. He also will give us the ultimate reward—a place in his presence forever.

We Are ALL Workers in God's Vineyard!

The first day of school for students in Grades 1-8 is Wednesday, September 7th. The students are to report to their last year's classroom no later than 8:15 A.M. The students should bring their lunch to school. Dismissal is at 2:45 P.M. All students in Grades 1-8 should be in either the summer or the formal uniform. The summer uniform is in effect from September 7th to October 15th for those who choose to wear it. Girls' skirts may not be more than 2 inches above the knee. Boys' hair must be short, neat and well-groomed. Students out of compliance with the uniform code will not be permitted to attend class. **New Students** should report to the Main Office. They will be escorted to the Library for an orientation. **Kindergarten will begin on Thursday, September 8th for students with last names A- L and Friday, September 9th for last names M-Z. These opening days for Kindergarten are full days.** The children should bring their lunch and a snack to school. They should assemble in the school yard behind the school no later than **8:30 A.M. on this day only.** Kindergarten parents should be present on the first day. In the event of rain,

we will assemble in the **Carlin Dining Hall.**

Kindergarten will dismiss at 2:45 P.M. for car riders and bus riders. Students with last names A-L do not report to school on Friday and Kindergarten students with last names M-Z do not report to school on Thursday. On Monday, September 12th and thereafter, all Kindergarten students should enter the school via the Carlin Doors on Clinton if they are a bus student or the Kindergarten Doors off the playground if they are using the Morning Drop-off. The Kindergarten Aides, Special Content Teachers, and Mrs. Brower will be on Clinton Ave. for the bus students, I will be in the back to assist the Morning Drop-off with additional teachers. A PDF of the school calendar is posted on the school's website, www.stagnes-school.org. It is located at the bottom of the website under Quick Links, "School Calendar and Handbook." The digital calendar is in the process of being posted month by month. **Please note that this year's school masses will be celebrated at 9:45 A.M., NOT at 9 A.M. as indicated on the printed calendar.**
