# Abstinence and Fasting

All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to observe the laws of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day.

You are invited to join us every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted) in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.



# Principal's Announcements

A Messiah For All People

At the time of the Messiah's coming, Rome held Israel



Jesus points ahead to "an hour" when worship "in Spirit and truth" will be offered to God not merely "on this mountain nor in Jerusalem," but everywhere in the world. Although the Jews are God's firstborn, we see in this passage that in Jesus, God's plan is for the whole world, for every soul.

Jesus encourages his disciples to look at the world anew and to see beyond the borders of Israel and beyond the national and racial limits of Jacob (Israel). "Open your eyes and see! The fields are shining for harvest!" he exclaims. The universal purpose of God's saving work in Christ is given its last word in the last line of this reading, appropriately spoken by the Samaritans: "This is truly the savior of the world!

Congratulations to our second graders who received the Sacrament of Penance for the first time last week. They were very nervous before they received the sacrament, but read what they had to say afterwards:

- "...great, better, and happy! I felt these things because I got a fresh start and my soul was clear."






