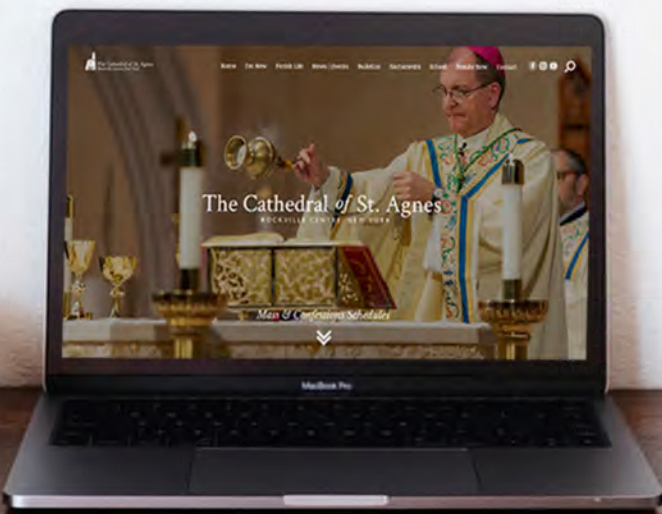

### Supreme Court Opinion Supports Freedom of Speech while also Strengthening Freedom of Religion

Some providers of creative services, such as web sites, tee shirts, cakes and floral arrangements have followed their consciences in support of traditional marriage and declined to use their creative abilities to celebrate and thereby approve and endorse same sex unions. They have offered all other of their services to same sex couples, but for these unique, very personal, products and services they explain their beliefs and offer referrals to other vendors.

Many lawsuits have been filed attempting to force these creative business owners to speak out in support of same sex unions through their unique designs. Such a case is the

one where Christian website designer, Lori Smith, who owns the business, Creative-303. Lori wanted to expand her business while sustaining her deeply held beliefs on traditional marriage.

However, as in the case of Jack Philips, the baker who also declined his artistic expression in support of same sex unions, Lori faced the Colorado Anti-Discrimination Act which would force her as well as the baker, to accept these projects.

After losing the 303 Creative LLC v. Elenis case in a lower court, Alliance Defending Freedom presented the case before the Supreme Court. The opinion of the Supreme Court, in favor of Creative-303, was that the Colorado law deprived citizens of their right to free speech.

## **Volunteers in the Diocese of Rockville Centre**

A person wishing to volunteer in any parish or organization in the Diocese of Rockville Centre must first complete three requirements:

1. Attend Protecting God's Children (Virtus)
2. Sign the Codes of Conduct
3. Complete a background screening application.

(Background screening is conducted on all volunteers and employees every 5 years.)

### **Directions to Complete the 3 Requirements:**

1. Sign up to attend a Protecting God's Children class: [www.Virtus.org](http://www.Virtus.org)

When you log on to the Virtus website, you will create a Virtus account.

- a. If you have not attended a Virtus class, you are a first time registrant.
- b. The first screen will ask the name of your organization-from the drop down list select **Rockville Centre-Safe Environment**.
- c. Follow all directions on the next screens.
- d. One screen will have the **Codes of Conduct**. Please acknowledge the Codes of Conduct.
- e. Continue with the registration process and select the class you will attend.
- f. After selecting the class, you will be instructed to complete the background screening application.

2. Background Screening Application:

- a. Sterling Volunteers is the company providing the background screening.
- b. Follow all the directions to complete the background screening application. **DO NOT STOP ONCE YOU BEGIN THE APPLICATION!** If you stop-you are locked out of the process due to security procedures.
- c. You will need to provide your Social Security #; if you do not provide a Social Security # you will be charged a fee.
- d. After completing the application, hit the 'Submit Button'

## COMUNIDAD HISPANA

### LA CATEDRAL DE SANTA INÉS

MISAS EN ESPAÑOL, Sábado - a las 7.30pm  
(Misa del Domingo)

Martes - a las 7.30pm (comenzando con el Rosario y  
confesión a las 7.00pm)

El XVI Domingo Ordinario nos presenta un conjunto de lecturas significativas. En la primera lectura, tomada del Libro de la Sabiduría (Sab 12, 13. 16-19), se nos recuerda que no hay otro Dios aparte del Señor, quien cuida de todas las cosas. Su justicia es incontestable y no está sujeta a rendir cuentas a nadie. La fuerza y el poder del Señor se manifiestan a aquellos que dudan de Su soberanía y desafían Su autoridad. Sin embargo, a pesar de Su poder, el Señor juzga con misericordia y gobierna con delicadeza, otorgando tiempo para que los pecadores se arrepientan y llenando a Sus hijos de esperanza.

El Salmo Responsorial (Salmo 85) nos invita a reconocer la bondad y la clemencia del Señor. Él es amoroso y compasivo con aquellos que lo invocan, y todas las naciones vendrán a adorarlo y glorificarlo.

En la segunda lectura (Romanos 8, 26-27), San Pablo nos enseña que el Espíritu Santo nos ayuda en nuestra debilidad. A menudo, no sabemos cómo orar adecuadamente, pero el Espíritu mismo intercede por nosotros con gemidos inefables.

El Evangelio según Mateo (13, 24-43) nos presenta tres parábolas de Jesús. 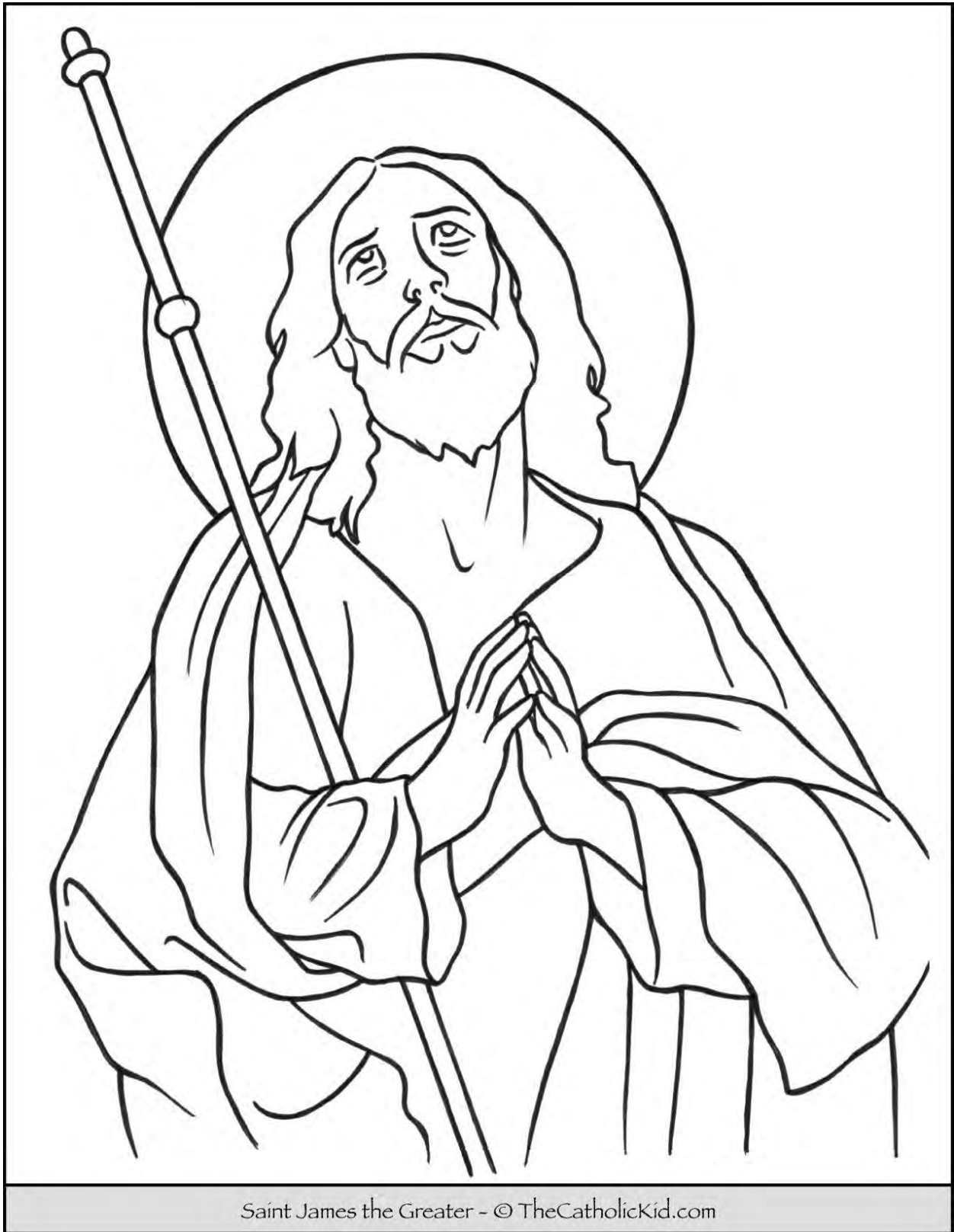
