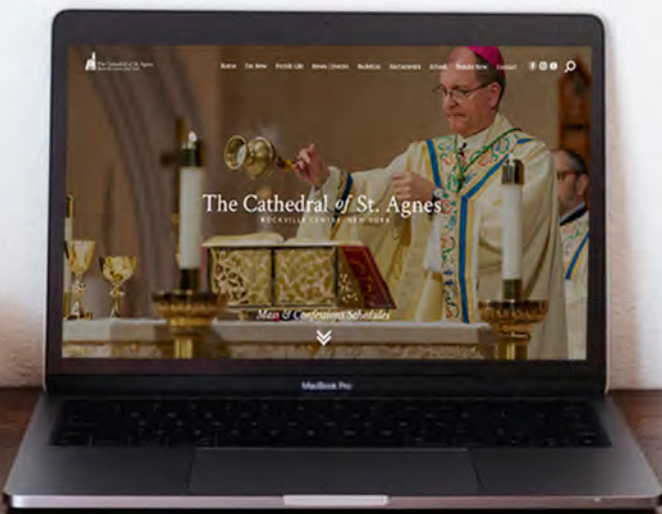

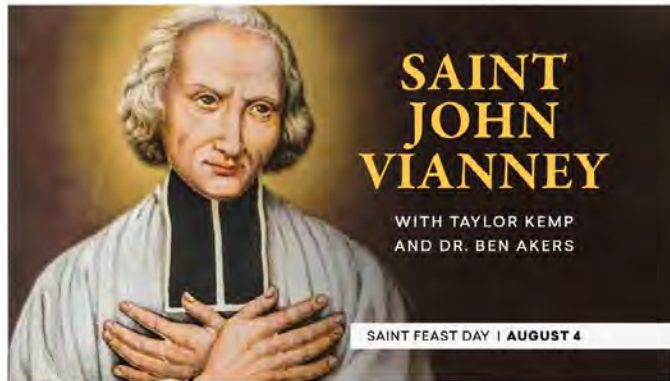

Catholic Laity Called to Defend the Church and Religious Freedom for All

The recent "honor" given to an anti-Catholic group by the LA Dodgers demonstrates that anti-Catholic sentiment can be publicly applauded with no fear of push back from a majority of Americans. The threat to all their freedoms posed by a Godless culture is unknown by most Americans because we have long failed to teach the Judeo-Christian foundations of our nation.

Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco expressed his gratitude to Catholics and Christians who joined together at the California stadium in protest of the Dodger's event and also protested at the capitol where a leader of the group was honored by some California lawmakers.

Pope Pius XII, Pope Benedict, Pope Francis and Cardinal Dolan are among church clergy who have called for the laity to use their charism (a special gift, an extraordinary power) from the Holy Spirit to fulfill the missions of the church.

We lay Catholics have the personal

Americans are blessed to live under a Constitution whose 1st Amendment protects us with a wall of separation, as explained by Pres. Thomas Jefferson, which directs our government not to interfere in our God given rights of conscience.

Ten years ago Catholic laity in the Diocese of Rockville Centre, NY came together to learn and teach the facts of religious freedom to fellow parishioners. With the support and encouragement of then Bishop William Murphy the group organized speaking events, religious freedom rallies, public witness rosaries, a student education video and materials, a Rosary for America booklet and initiative and much more.

PRACTICE FORGIVENESS

After Steven was shot in Central Park, paralyzed, unable to speak, with his pregnant wife, Patti Ann at his side, he realized he wouldn't live to meet his son if he didn't forgive the 14 year old who shot him. Steven became aware forgiveness was the medicine he needed to live. He publicly forgave Shaved Jones on the day his son was baptized. His statement, read by Patti Ann, moved Jones to call the McDonald home and apologize. Steven was reminded daily what this young man's actions took from him and forgave him everyday. Beyond doctor's expectations, Steven lived over 30 years carrying his cross with Jesus, spreading the message "Why Forgive?"

Blessing our enemies after acknowledging what they took from us are the steps needed to free us from the toxicity of bitterness and resentment. Bitterness slowly kills us and blocks the graces God has for us to live an abundant life despite the pain and wounds from the actions of others. When we are reminded of the hurt and wounds caused by others, it is a sign we need to forgive again

Steven took 3 STEPS TO FORGIVE:
He named the person he was willing to forgive, acknowledged what was taken from him and prayed for the person by asking God to bless him.

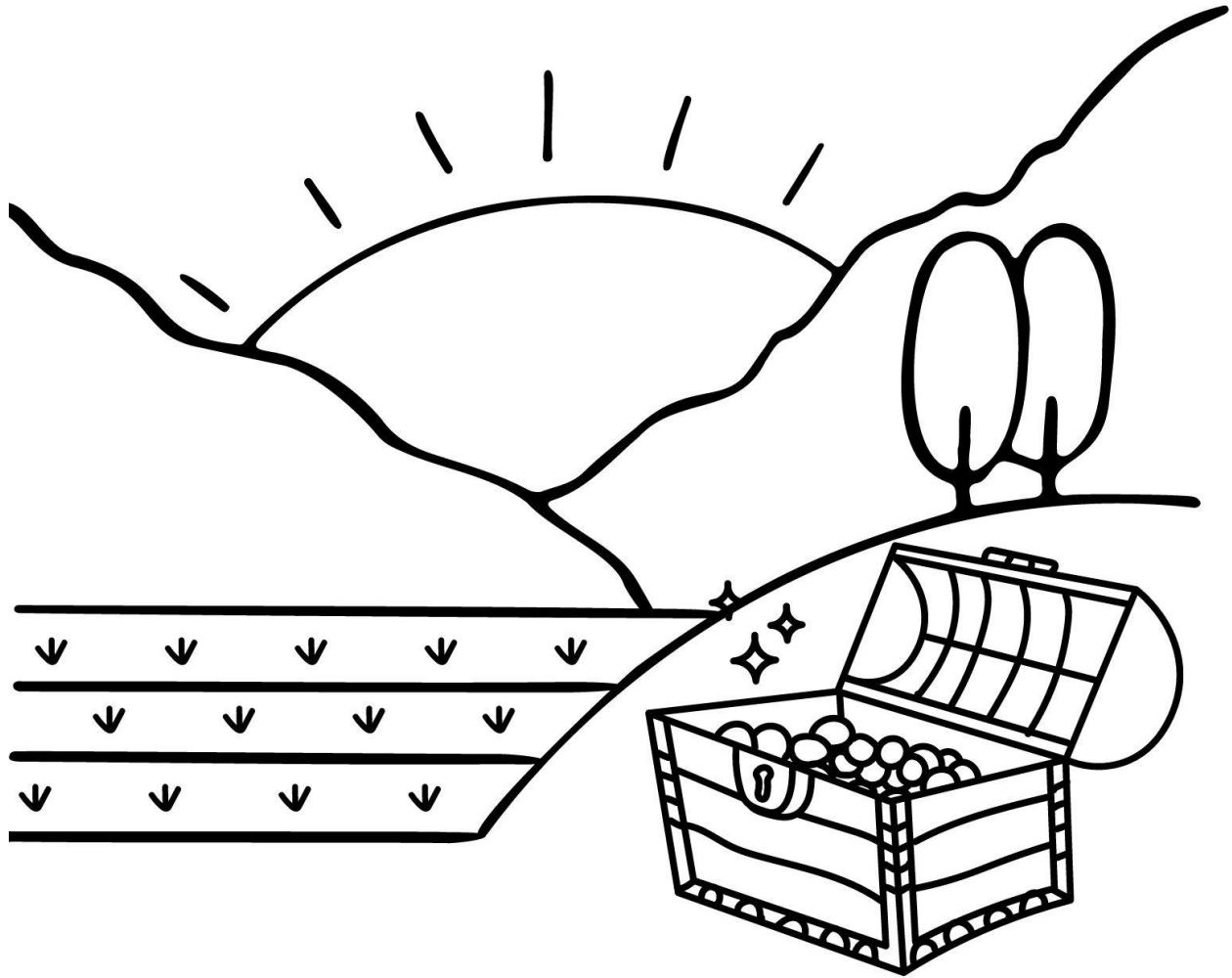
