**Eucharistic Adoration** is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

# Principal's Announcements



#### Remain in My Love

Last week, we saw Jesus use the analogy of the vine and branches to teach us about discipleship. To be fruitful disciples, we need to abide in him. In the Gospel passage for this week, Jesus tells us that we abide in him through love. Jesus loves his disciples with the divine love that the Father gives him. This selfless love is the very same love manifested by the Father when he sends his son into the world.

The assurance of this love brings us joy and calls for a response from us, the same kind of response that Jesus gives the Father through unconditional obedience to him. We also must manifest our reciprocal love to God through obedience to his commandments. The love that Jesus gives and desires in return is not a purely emotional love based on feelings but one that is based on action, specifically in laying down one's life for the good of others just as Jesus did for each of us. Our Christian joy spurs us on to this Christ-like love.

Our joy is founded on our friendship with Christ. Jesus calls his disciples friends for whom he lays down his life. We are no longer slaves because we share in the same mission with Jesus. However, our friendship is based on obedience in the same way that the love of the Father and the Son requires obedience. We have been called by Jesus to share in his friendship and mission to bring Christ's love to others and bear fruit for the kingdom. As privileged members of God's family, chosen by him and with our wills aligned to his, we can confidently bring all our needs to God in prayer entrusted to the name of Jesus, knowing that God will answer our prayers.

Antonio Vivaldi's "Gloria" RV 589

J. S. Bach's "Magnificat in D Major" BWV 243

The Cathedral Choirs and Orchestra

Michael L. Bower, Conductor



The St. Agnes Music Department will continue the tradition of presenting great sacred classical music masterworks with the performance of these two gems, composed for choir, orchestra, and soloists. Vivaldi's setting of the Gloria takes on the form of an extended cantata, where the various parts of the text are given a separate movement. Vivaldi composed this setting of the Gloria text when working at the famous orphanage turned music school: the Ospedale della Pieta in Venice, Italy.

Bach's setting of the Magnificat takes a similar format of dividing up the texts for the purposes of creating individual movements. Bach was newly appointed to the St. Thomas Church (Thomaskirche), Leipzig, Germany, when the 1st performance took place in 1723, 300 years ago this past year! The orchestration is a delight to hear, as are the choral and vocal solo parts. The challenging Baroque music is further decorated by the use of five-part singing of the Choir (SSATB)!

### Focus on Religious Freedom

Sexual orientation and gender ideology have been added to the traditional definition of sex as male and female for the purposes of Title IX of the 1972 Federal Education Amendments. Title IX gave women equal opportunities to men in sports, scholarships, and programs in schools by preventing discrimination in activities and programs which receive federal funding.


The administration's changes to Title IX, as of Aug.1, 2024, will conflict with the religious beliefs of millions of Americans whose faiths teach that God created two sexes, male and female. Teachers and students whose religious beliefs in this regard differ from this newly mandated definition will be at risk of discipline, termination and religious discrimination if they continue to live and exercise their faith as set forth in the 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment.

The new rule equates self-chosen gender identity with God-given biological sex and says that a person's self-chosen gender identity cannot prevent their participation in <u>any</u> education program or activity. Attorneys studying the redefinitions foresee that the rule will not allow separate bathrooms, locker rooms, and housing for biological males and females and that women's sports will be endangered. The rule will give legal support to those state and local governments that are already making policy and forcing adherence to these cultural influences.

Following the same ideology, New York state will vote this Nov.5 on a state Constitutional amendment to expand the equal protection clause of the New York state constitution. That clause currently protects from discrimination by race, color, creed or religion. Proposed changes would add protected categories of age, gender identity, gender expression, reproductive healthcare and autonomy.

The federal Title IX redefinitions and proposed New York state's constitutional amendment are seen by many as cultural bombs.... imposing an ideology that denies millions of Americans important and basic religious beliefs as well as their right to live their faith and educate their children in their faith.

As summarized by an attorney familiar with these issues, "These redefinitions at the federal and state levels are the same in their intent. However, because one is a federal law and the other a state constitutional amendment, they can be weaponized in different ways by different government entities and private citizens, with different penalties and civil damages that can be levied in different regulatory and judicial forums. So, they open a multi-front war. That dangerous fact should not be underestimated."
