Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

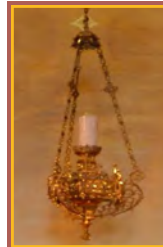

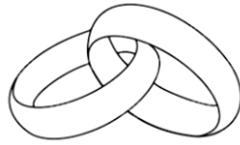

Principal's Announcements



27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings from Genesis and the Gospel of St. Mark (10:2–16) together show how Jesus claims to have greater authority than Moses, which would have shocked the Pharisees. When the Pharisees question him concerning divorce, he effectively reestablishes the divine law concerning the sacrament of marriage from the very beginning by citing Genesis 2:24. He explains that Moses allowed divorce for the hardness of their hearts.

After reaffirming the indissolubility of the marriage covenant, Jesus turns immediately to the question of children. Just as God had said "Be fertile and multiply" to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 1: 28), so now Jesus, after restoring marriage to its proper dignity as an indissoluble bond, says "Let the children come to me and do not hinder them. It is to just such as these that the kingdom of God belongs. This lesson is profound, because it reveals the essential importance of the unitive and procreative ends of marriage. The couple become one flesh through consummating marriage, and through this union, children will be brought into the world and then baptized for the Kingdom of God.

To accept this teaching, one must become like a little child oneself. A child is one who trusts his or her parents to provide every need, to heal every wound. The Father hopes that we will trust ourselves to Him like little children.

*...I Have Set Before You Life and Death,
Blessings and Curses...Deuteronomy 30:19*

In 1976, our bicentennial year, Cardinal Karol Wojtyla, then the Polish archbishop of Krakow and soon to be named Pope John Paul II, visited Philadelphia for the 41st International Eucharistic Congress. These stunning and enigmatic remarks are from Cardinal Wojtyla's last speech before leaving America:

"We are now standing in the face of the greatest historical confrontation humanity has gone through. I do not think that wide circles of the American society or wide circles of the Christian community realize this fully. We are now facing the final confrontation between the Church and the anti-Church, of the Gospel versus the anti-Gospel. This confrontation lies within the plans of divine Providence; it is trial which the whole Church, and the Polish Church in particular, must take up. It is a trial of not only our nation and the Church, but, in a sense, a test of 2,000 years of culture and Christian civilization with all of its consequences for human dignity, individual rights, human rights and the rights of nations."

Each day, and strikingly during our recent election seasons,

we see this test of our culture and of Christian civilization as it is threatened by chaos and evil.

Will Americans make the choice to protect life at all stages? Will Americans turn increasingly from the Biblical truth of Genesis 5:2 "He created them male and female and blessed them. And he named them "Mankind"?

Will we choose to recognize that parents are the rightful teachers, nurturing their children's faith and practices and stewarding their education?

Will our citizens insist on respect for the person and property of others as is commanded in our Judeo-Christian ethos...thou shalt not kill, thou shalt not steal...thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife...thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's goods?

Will Americans respect the truth, a respect fundamental to human civilization...thou shalt not bear false witness?

Will Americans strive to afford each citizen the right to follow his own conscience as intended with the establishment of religious freedom as this nation's First Freedom? Will Americans sacrifice to preserve the Constitution, seen as a providential miracle by those who painstakingly and bravely constructed it with intelligence, passion, goodwill and faith?

Will we convey the liberties of our Constitutional Republic to ages and millions yet unborn?

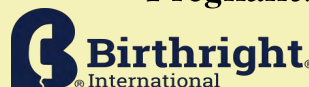
