First Sunday of Lent



Principal's Announcements

This Sunday's Gospel begins by reflecting on Jesus' time in the desert, where he faces three temptations from Satan. These temptations mirror the same tactics Satan uses today to lead us away from God. First, Satan challenges Jesus' identity as the Son of God, just as he tries to undermine our identity as children of God. Second, Satan offers Jesus the kingdoms of the world, tempting us to seek power and control. Lastly, Satan urges Jesus to fulfill his mission in a way other than God's plan, similar to how we are tempted to find easier or "more successful" paths in life. Jesus resists all three temptations with God's Word, showing the power of Scripture to overcome evil. This highlights the importance of grounding ourselves in Scripture to defend against temptation. We are invited to reflect on this Gospel and learn how to better resist temptation in our own lives.

This week our after-school enrichment classes begin. Please make sure to update your child's Pick Up Patrol account to reflect changes in dismissal due to attendance in enrichment classes.

Registration for **new** students to the school for the 2025-26 school year is currently in effect. To register, the following documents are needed:

- Birth Certificate
- Baptismal Certificate (if applicable)
- Current Report Card and Standardized Testing for students in grades 1-7

Parish Envelope Number (if applicable)

Students entering kindergarten must be 5 years old by December 1, 2025. The following non-refundable fees are due at registration:

• Kindergarten: \$300

Grades 1-7: \$150

Acceptance is based on the successful completion of Kindergarten and 1st grade screenings. For students in Grades 2-8, acceptance will be determined following a review of transcripts and an interview with the principal.

Tuition assistance is available through the Tomorrow's Hope Foundation. The 2025-26 scholarship application opened on January 16th and is due by April 30th. For more information, please visit <u>Tomorrow's Hope Foundation</u>. **Transportation Reminder**: If your child resides in a district outside of Rockville Centre, please remember that you must register for transportation for the 2025-26 school year. Notification to your district is required by April 1st—no exceptions. Contact your district's transportation department to request the necessary application.
