

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

The Cost of True Discipleship

Today's Gospel reading challenges us to consider what it truly means to be a disciple of Jesus. He says that no one is worthy to be called his disciple unless they "hate" their family members for his sake, take up their cross to follow him, and renounce their possessions. At first, this sounds extreme. However, in the Hebrew tradition, to "hate" one thing and "love" another simply meant to give preference to one over the other. Jesus is teaching us that to be his disciple, we must put God above all else, even our own family. When God is in the right place, everything else in our lives will also fall into place.

Jesus' popularity was at a peak when he shared these words. Crowds were following him, but he turned to them with a challenge: to love him above all others. It can be easy to get excited about our faith, but it's much harder to live it out daily. Are we truly following in Jesus' footsteps?

Introducing New Saints

We're excited to announce two new saints to add to our list of intercessors: **Saint Carlo Acutis** and **Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati**. Both young men were canonized today in Rome by our new American Pope, Pope Leo XIV. Both of these saints were remarkably devoted to the Eucharist. Students and teachers will watch a film about Saint Carlo Acutis to learn about his extraordinary, yet short, life. As a teenager, Carlo experienced a deep presence of God in the Eucharist, spending time in front of the Blessed Sacrament every day. He found a joy many of us spend our whole lives searching for, and he once called the Eucharist his "highway to heaven." This is a powerful reminder that Jesus wants to meet us right where we are—in the Eucharist.

All students will receive a prayer card for both saints and a button of Saint Carlo Acutis.




