You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Persistency in Prayer

The need to pray is always linked to Jesus' description of the events leading up to "when the Son of Man comes," or end of time when Christ will come again. Understanding the context of this passage helps us to see that constancy in prayer isn't simply a requirement so that the petitioner will get what he or she wants. Rather, constant prayer ensures that we'll be on the side of God's justice when he comes because our prayer is a demonstration of faith. It takes faith to pray, and faith is the means to our justification, holiness, and righteousness in the sight of God. In order for Jesus to find justice, righteousness, or holiness when he comes again as judge of the living and the dead, believers must be steadfast in prayer.

So Jesus isn't so much suggesting that we nag God until we get what we want, as is sometimes thought, but that we pray often, indeed constantly, so that we'll be the holy, faith-filled people he longs to find upon his return. Otherwise, his justice can only work to our disadvantage. What's just for the sinner and just for the righteous are two very different things, and it's prayer in faith that makes the difference.

As we enter a new week, please be reminded that the formal uniforms begin this week.

Progress Reports will be distributed to students on Thursday. These reports offer an opportunity to reflect on the first part of the school year and to continue encouraging the students to do their best in all they do.

The week will close with the Fathers' Club Cornhole Tournament, a fun community event that brings our families together in friendship and school spirit.

As we move through this week, let us remember the importance of persistence in prayer. Just as we encourage our students to persevere in their studies, we too are called to remain steadfast in prayer, trusting that God hears us, even in moments of waiting. "Pray without ceasing."



10 Popes Have Explicitly Condemned Socialism

Socialism was strongly condemned by Pope Leo XIII in 1891 in his encyclical, Rerum Novarum:

“It is clear that the main tenet of socialism, community of goods, must be utterly rejected, since it only injures those whom it would seem meant to benefit, is directly contrary to the natural rights of mankind and would introduce confusion and disorder into the commonweal.”

Summary of Pope Leo XIII’s condemnation of socialism:

1. Socialism promotes envy between classes. “Thou shalt not covet thy neighbors goods.”
2. The transfer of private property to community property is against nature and justice.
3. Socialism hurts the working man first and foremost.
4. A person has the right to improve his social condition through labor. His social condition should not be taken away from him.
5. The Pope recognizes that not every human has equal aptitude in this life for wage-earning.
6. Labor is good and not evil. Socialism wrongly presumes that work is always an exploitation of one class serving another class.
7. It is evident in these quotes, that those who have acquired private property should share their goods with those who are in need. This is the call to almsgiving that Proverbs and Christ repeatedly exhort us to practice.


