You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.

Principal's Announcements



Our modern culture emphasizes strength, competence, and self-sufficiency, often rejecting weakness and neediness. In stark contrast, this week's readings call us to embrace our inherent poverty and neediness, allowing God to transform it—and us—into incredible riches.

God is drawn to us in our need, just as a parent is to a child. The Gospel illustrates this with the story of the Pharisee and the tax collector. While the Pharisee approaches God with confident assertion, the tax collector comes with humility, recognizing his need. He is a model for us, demonstrating the Gospel way to approach God: in humility, as a "poor man." When we admit our poverty, God stands ready to fill our emptiness with His Spirit.

This theme is reinforced throughout the readings: "The Lord hears the cry of the poor," and "The prayer of the lowly pierces the clouds." The lesson this week is a call to a radically different life—one that embraces our poverty so God can become our richness, our weakness so God can be our strength, and our neediness so God will hear and answer our prayers.


