

Eucharistic Adoration is the traditional Catholic practice of taking the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament, and placing it in a sun-shaped vessel called a Monstrance in order for the faithful to look upon Our Lord and pray to Him in peaceful contemplation. You are invited to join us **every Wednesday (unless otherwise noted)** in the Cathedral from 2:00–5:00 p.m. for Adoration and some quiet reflection and prayer.

The Rosary is prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Mass each Monday through Friday in the Cathedral except on Saturdays when it is prayed after the 7:45 a.m. Mass.



Don't Be Spiritually Asleep

In this week's Gospel, Jesus is warning his disciples about being unconcerned, or spiritually unaware or asleep. He compares this to the people who were caught by the flood in Noah's day. They weren't doing anything obviously bad; they were just busy with normal, everyday life (eating, drinking, marrying), but they were unconscious of God in the middle of it all.

Jesus uses this same idea to describe his second coming. He says two people will be doing the exact same ordinary thing, yet one will be saved and the other won't. Nothing suggests one was sinning and the other wasn't. The difference is wakefulness. What separates the two is spiritual attention or wakefulness. The point is not *knowing* when Jesus will return but knowing that he will return and being ready for it.

Just like a homeowner who doesn't know when a thief will strike must stay watchful and prepared, Jesus tells his followers to live in a constant state of spiritual readiness.

The Fathers' Club will host its annual Christmas Tree Lighting this week.

The students in Grade 6 will participate in an Advent Retreat. The week will end with the Mothers' Club Rudolph Run.

Peace and blessings to you and your families on this 1st Sunday of Advent.


