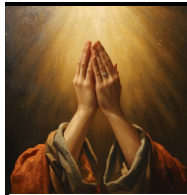

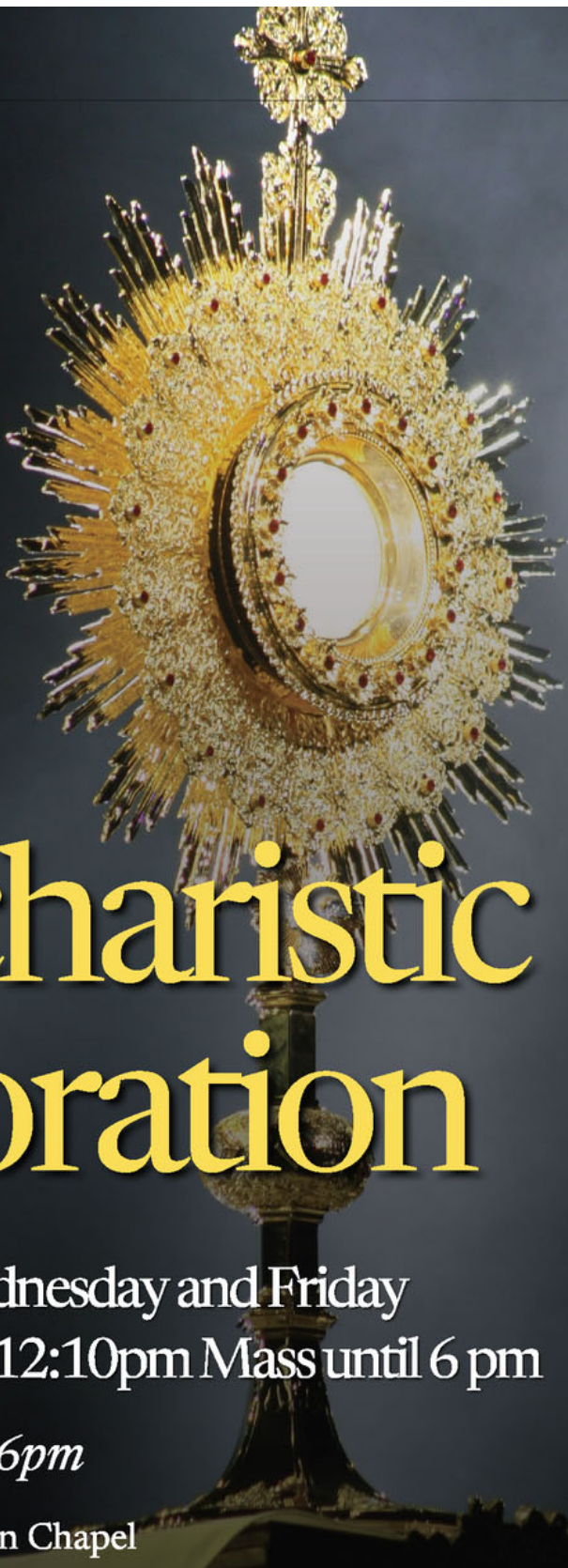

New HHS Website Promotes Life-Affirming Care for Mothers and Children

"The care of human life and happiness, and not their destruction, is the first and only legitimate object of good government." - Thomas Jefferson, 1809

On June 24, 2022, the U.S. Supreme Court overturned the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* ruling and returned law-making authority regarding abortion to the people's elected representatives.

Four years later, there is much to be done to build a culture of life. Critically important is creating an environment that welcomes new life, provides care and support for mothers and children, and works to affirm and strengthen healthy family life.

To that end, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services launched Moms.gov to deliver "critical tools and support to help parents foster healthy pregnancies, strengthen young families, and create brighter futures for their children" per HHS Secretary Kennedy.

Finally, in the spirit of Thomas Jefferson's words, the federal government is directing resources toward the care and nurturing of new human lives, rather than their destruction.

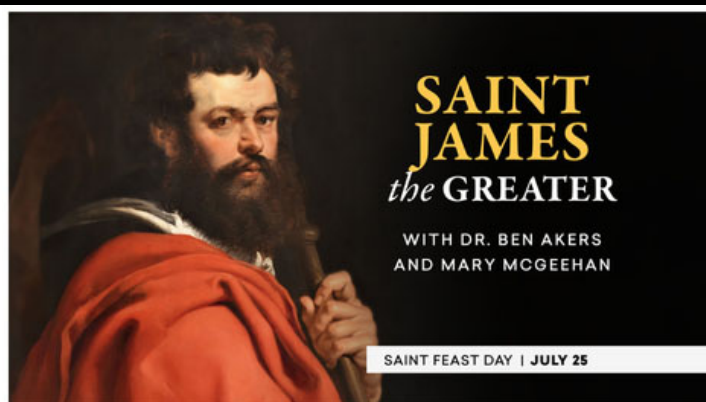
As the National Catholic Register reports at <https://tinyurl.com/2pdhzyw9> the website directs people to Pregnancy Resource Centers that oppose abortion and provide a range of life-affirming services to mothers, children, and families.

Moms.gov also provides links to Federally Qualified Health Centers that "provide high-quality care, including primary care services, maternal care, and prenatal care" to low-income Americans. While "not ideologically opposed to abortion," the Register notes, most FQHCs do not perform abortions.

As we commemorate the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence, Moms.gov is a welcome initiative that honors that document's proclamation of human equality, and of our natural rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness endowed by our Creator.

En nuestra presencia dominical en la iglesia para celebrar el día del Señor, debemos aplicar la paciencia de Dios enseñada hoy en el Evangelio, conscientes de que somos la Iglesia santa y la Iglesia pecadora, todo a la vez; la Iglesia sin mancha ni arruga y la Iglesia que dice «perdónanos nuestras deudas»

Tanto el libro de la Sabiduría como el salmo responsorial de hoy nos hablan de la benignidad y la indulgencia de un Dios “clemente y compasivo, lleno de amor y fiel”, cuya justicia se armoniza perfectamente con su compasión. Un mensaje que, de algún modo, también está implícito en la parábola que leemos hoy en el evangelio de Mateo. El trigo y la cizaña crecen juntos, el bien y el mal conviven en la historia humana, pero sólo a la hora del juicio Dios separará a ambos.

El Evangelio de San Mateo nos trae hoy tres parábolas de Jesús, muy breves y con mayor énfasis en la del trigo y la cizaña, con una explicación que nos sirve para aplicarla a nuestra vida cristiana.
