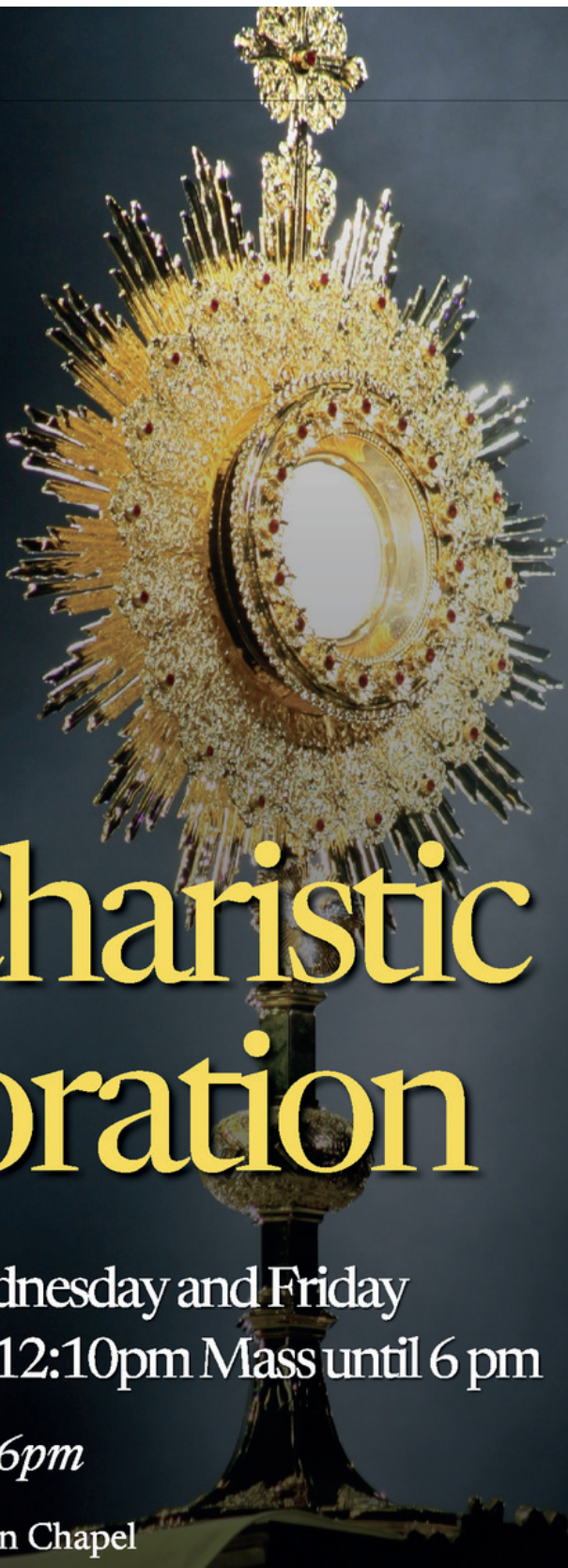

Conscience Rights and Safety of Pro-life and Christian Americans to be Protected

HHS Restores Conscience and Religious Freedom Division to Civil Rights Office

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has restored a Conscience and Religious Freedom Division within its Office for Civil Rights (OCR) as established by the Trump administration in 2018, but discontinued by the Biden administration in 2023.

“This reorganization,” HHS Secretary Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. said, “strengthens the Office for Civil Rights’ ability to defend religious liberty, enforce conscience protections, and combat unlawful discrimination.”

Per HHS: “The new structure will advance the protection of conscience rights, address race-based discrimination in a color-blind manner, eradicate antisemitism and anti-Christian bias, and restore biological truth.”

Expressing gratitude to the current administration “for prioritizing the conscience rights and religious liberty of all Americans,” Mary Szoch, Director of the Center for Human Dignity at Family Research Council, expressed hope “that the work of this office will result in a greater respect for human dignity and religious freedom around the country.”

El hilo conductor del pensamiento en las lecturas bíblicas es la oposición entre lo transitorio y lo eterno. El libro de los Reyes nos presenta el inicio del reinado de Salomón, el rey sabio por antonomasia que, antes que bienes y gloria, pide a Dios sabiduría para gobernar con justicia. Ésta es la misma experiencia que refleja el salmista al decir que ama los mandatos del Señor porque le ayudan a vivir más que cualquier otro bien. El sueño de Salomón en Gabaón ilustra las parábolas del tesoro y de la perla que leemos en el evangelio: Jesús nos dice que la verdadera sabiduría es la del que sabe despojarse para adquirir el nuevo modo de ver la realidad que trae el Reino por él inaugurado. Ese tesoro del Reino está dentro de nosotros mismos, pues llevamos marcada la impronta de Dios y estamos destinados, como dice Pablo, a reproducir la imagen de su Hijo, despojándonos del hombre viejo.

Seguimos y concluimos hoy el capítulo que Mateo dedica a las parábolas de Jesús, con las que nos transmite un mensaje religioso, los rasgos del Reino que él quiere establecer en este mundo. Las parábolas de hoy nos hablan de la sabiduría de quienes eligen el tesoro y la perla. Para entender estas parábolas, hay que estar atentos.

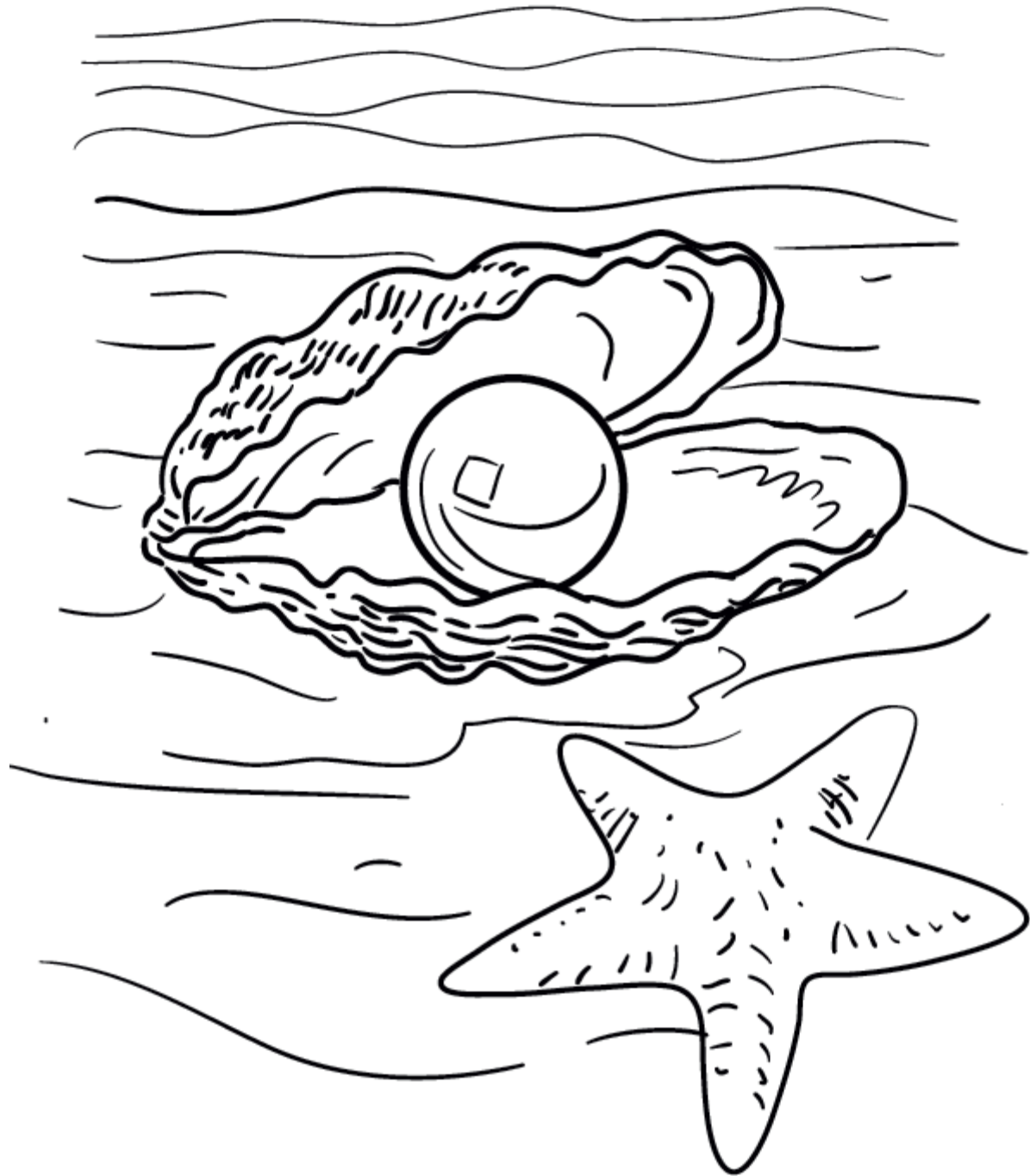

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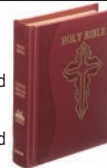
