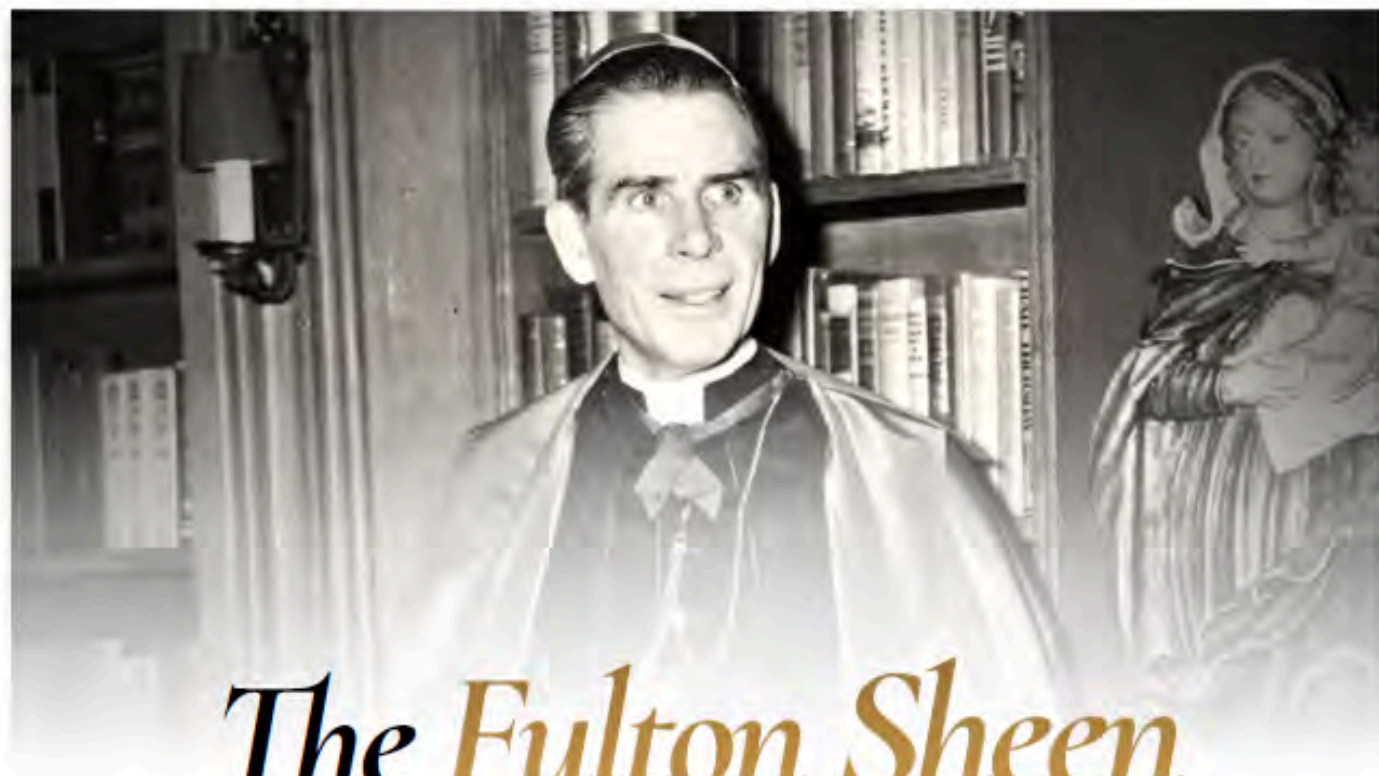

St Agnes School: Pray Beautifully, Live Beautifully

It is with great joy and gratitude that I welcome you to a new school year at St. Agnes Cathedral School. As I begin my journey as your new principal, I am deeply honored to build upon the beautiful legacy established by Mrs. Cecilia St. John. Inspired by her dedication, I look forward to continuing the tradition of sharing a weekly reflection with our parish community—strengthening the vital bond between our school and parish family as we grow together in faith, learning, and service.

As we begin a new school year, we do so with a renewed sense of purpose and a deep desire to place Christ at the heart of all that we do. Our theme for the 2026–2027 school year, St. Agnes Cathedral School: Pray Beautifully, Live Beautifully, invites us to make prayer the foundation of our lives and to allow our faith to shape the way we live, learn, and serve others.

As we reflect on this theme, we turn to our anchor Scripture passage for the year, Luke 11:1–13. In this Gospel, the disciples ask Jesus, “Lord, teach us to pray.” Jesus responds by giving them the Our Father, a prayer that teaches us to honor God, trust Him for our daily needs, seek forgiveness, forgive others, and ask for His guidance.

Jesus then reminds us to pray with persistence: “Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.” Finally, He assures us that God is a loving Father who desires to give good gifts to His children, especially the gift of the Holy Spirit.

For our St. Agnes students, teachers, and families, this Gospel reminds us that a beautiful life begins with a relationship with God. We pray beautifully when we speak honestly to God and trust in His presence. We live beautifully when that prayer transforms the way we treat one another: with patience, compassion, forgiveness, generosity, and love

Back to School Information

The first day of school for students in Grades 1-8 is Tuesday, September 8th. The students are to report to last year's classroom no later than 8:15. The students should bring their lunch to school. Dismissal is at 2:45 PM. Aftercare will be available.

Kindergarten will begin on Wednesday, September 9th. Kindergarten parents should be present on the first day. They should assemble in the schoolyard behind the school at 8:30 A.M. An opening ceremony for the Kindergarten students will take place, followed by the calling of the class lists. After all the students are sorted into their homerooms, parents are warmly invited to accompany their child to their classroom, helping them settle into their new surroundings. In the event of rain, we will assemble in the Carlin Dining Hall. Kindergarten will dismiss at 2:45 P.M. for car riders and bus riders. The Kindergarten children should bring their lunch, a snack, and their supplies to school. On Thursday September 10th, and thereafter, all Kindergarten students should enter the school via the Carlin Doors on Clinton if they are bus students or the Kindergarten Doors off the playground if they are using the Morning Drop-off. The Kindergarten Aides, Special Content Teachers, and Mrs. Brower will be on Clinton Avenue for the bus students. I will be in the back to assist with the Morning Drop-off with additional teachers.

Hoy las lecturas se centran en los designios insondables de Dios para elegir a quienes él quiere poner al frente de su pueblo. Resalta la elección de Pedro, como piedra visible sobre la que funda su Iglesia y la entrega de las llaves del Reino de los Cielos. Por eso nos reunimos aquí los que profesamos una misma fe: nuestra fe en Jesucristo, el Señor; nuestra fe, fundada en el testimonio de los apóstoles.

El profeta Isaías presenta la sustitución de un mayordomo real. El traspaso de poderes está simbolizado, entre otros distintivos, en la entrega de llaves, una imagen que remite al evangelio de Mateo y recuerda la nueva misión que Jesús encarga a Simón Pedro como servidor de su Iglesia. Ante esta decisión del Señor, brota del corazón creyente una oración de alabanza que bien puede ser la que expresa Pablo en la Carta a los Romanos: "¡Qué insondables sus decisiones!", y otra de petición que se hace eco del salmo: "No abandones la obra de tus manos".

A la confesión cristológica que Pedro hace en el evangelio de hoy, le sigue la promesa hecha a éste como primero en rango entre todos los apóstoles por haber sido objeto de una especial iluminación. La continuidad de Jesús en su Iglesia pasa por Pedro y sus sucesores. El que tiene las llaves puede abrir y cerrar.

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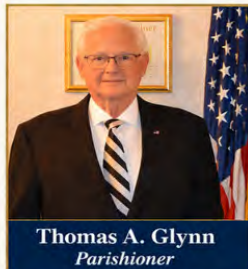
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
