Kerygma means “proclamation” and is the essential proclamation of the Good News of Jesus Christ handed on by the Apostles: that Jesus Christ, crucified and risen, is Lord and Savior, and that through faith in him and conversion of heart we receive forgiveness of sins and new life.

In this first session, we will explore the first part of the Kerygma—our relationship with God: His plan for the human person, and what it means to enter into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and to live out that relationship within His Church.

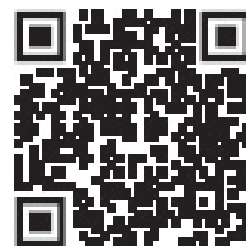

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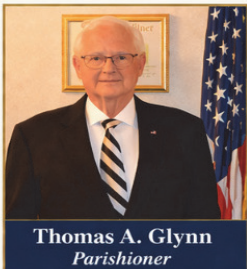
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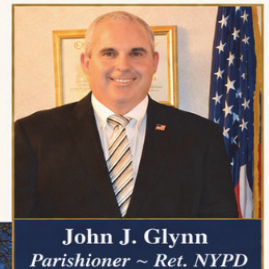
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
